Lesner Pointe Condominium Association VIRGINIA FAIR HOUSING ACT PROCEDURE

- 1. Upon delivery of request, respond quickly confirming date of receipt.
- 2. Engage in a good-faith interactive process if there are questions. Seek legal guidance as needed.
- 3. Approve unless it causes **undue financial/administrative burden** or fundamentally alters the community's operations.
- 4. Request more information only about:
 - Whether you have a disability
 - How the requested change relates to that disability

5. Decision

- Approval:
 - o **Accommodation:** Implement change to policy, rule or regulation
 - Modification: Permit work to proceed with clear construction conditions including agreement for restoration at termination of applicant's need. Photograph before/after for recordkeeping, include thorough description of work performed.
- Denial:
 - Explain the reason
 - o Applicant can revise the request, offer alternatives, or challenge the denial

6. Dispute

- Try to resolve through further discussion.
- If unresolved, applicant may:
 - File a complaint within 1 year to:
 - Virginia Fair Housing Office (VFHO) under the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation.
 - HUD's Office of Fair Housing & Equal Opportunity.
 - File a lawsuit in state or federal court within 2 years.

7. After Implementation

- Retain records
- If modified, applicant must comply with any restoration terms in agreement with Association upon sale of vacating residence
