CAVE MONT BLANC - Morgex (Ao)

When we perceive the enthusiasm, determination, and responsibility of a young president of a historic cooperative in their eyes and words, and of a rare wine, as we drink it, we look at the world and the mountains with optimism and listen to it with pleasure. The Prié Blanc, the native white grape variety that forms the basis of Blanc de Morgex et de La Salle, has a fascinating and memorable history. Robust and faithful to itself for millennia, this self-rooted vine climbs the steep slopes of the valleys, reaching and surpassing 1200 meters above sea level. As Abbé Don Alexandre Bougeat once said, Prié Blanc «thrives in the face of avalanches»: a statement that is more true than ever as just a few meters away, one of the most imposing avalanches in the Alpine arc descends. This further testifies to the wild, yet refined taste of Prié Blanc, the grape variety that offers a unique and rare fruit. The white berry it gives us becomes, in fact, the fruit of the last sun, before Mont Blanc captures it in its nighttime heart, rich in crystals.

LA SOURCE - Saint-Pierre (Ao)

The company is located in Saint-Pierre, a small village situated geographically in the center of the Aosta Valley, behind the ancient and magnificent castle that bears the same name. The area has been famous for centuries for viticulture as it is fully exposed to the sun and sheltered from the cold winds coming from the north. The company is run, with the help of the family, by Stefano Celi who has chosen to work with both international and traditional grape varieties.

CAVES COOPERATIVES DE DONNAS - Donnas (Ao)

Entering the Aosta Valley, at the entrance of the Gressoney Valley, extraordinary vineyards rise, an absolute symbol of human industriousness on the mountains. In 1971, some winemakers decided to create a cooperative that, with tenacity and determination, could help keep the Picotendro alive, one of the mountain clones of Nebbiolo. The vineyards are entirely terraced and built on pergolas supported by monumental pillars. With the aim of enhancing and protecting the vineyards with the steepest slopes (exceeding 100%), since 2020 a product line has been dedicated to ensuring a dignified remuneration for the work of these extreme winemakers.

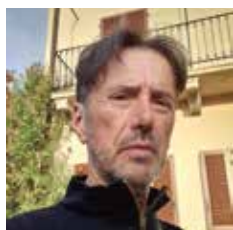
MALEY - Brissogne (Ao)

Maley is the ancient name for the apple cultivated in Valtournenche, at the foot of the Matterhorn, and is one of the ancient names given to Mont Blanc in the Chamonix Valley. Located in the heart of the Aosta Valley, in the municipality of Brissogne, this company aims to promote and make known the beauty and harmony of the centuries-old apple trees of Mont Blanc and the Matterhorn, which Gianluca Telloli has contributed to saving from extinction: Raventze, Renetta di Antey, Barbelune, and Groin de Veau.

BARNI - Brusnengo (Bi)

Giuseppe Barni, after an initial experience in Gattinara, decided in the early 1990s to revive one of the epic crus of northern Piedmont: the Mesolone. This vineyard is located on the hills of Brusnengo, already mentioned by Soldati and Veronelli: centuries-old vines cultivated with Croatina and Uva Rara, grown in the Maggiorina style. The company is a historic interpreter of Bramaterra and produces a surprising passito made from Erbaluce grapes. The Alto Piedmont is a hidden treasure trove of varieties capable of expressing great elegance.

BOSCHIS Francesco - Dogliani (Cn)

The company has been in existence since 1919, but it was with the 1968 harvest that Francesco and his son Mario decided to start vinifying their own batch of Dolcetto, which remains the main grape variety to this day. Today, the company is run by Mario with his sons Marco and Paolo, who have completely eliminated the use of systemic pesticide products. The vineyards, largely worked by hand, are located at over 500 meters above sea level, with only the most suitable soils dedicated to vine cultivation, while others are used for hazelnut orchards, fields, meadows, and forests. The company also maintains a small herd of Piemontese cattle, which provide the organic matter necessary for fertilization.

CASCINA GILLI - Castelnuovo Don Bosco (At)

Since 1983, Cascina Gilli has been enhancing the indigenous grape varieties of Monferrato, starting with Freisa, a versatile and contemporary variety. The company is located in Castelnuovo Don Bosco, in Monferrato Astigiano, one of the areas of Piedmont still waiting to be fully discovered, which has always proudly and independently written its history through the voice of the land. Here, 11 hectares of vineyards are cultivated with Freisa, Malvasia di Schierano, Bonarda, Barbera, and Nebbiolo among the clayey hills in the Marne di Sant'Agata. Among the most iconic labels are Freisa d'Asti, refined, elegant, and aromatic, and Malvasia di Castelnuovo Don Bosco, aromatic and timeless. CASCINA DEL MONASTERO - La Morra (Cn)

In the heart of the Piedmontese Langhe, in La Morra, in the prestigious Annunziata hamlet, Cascina del Monastero, with its vineyards fully bathed in sunlight, has been carrying on the family winemaking tradition for five generations. Among the rows, organic farming is practiced, with no herbicides or pesticides used, only sulfur and copper treatments, aimed at preserving the beauty and naturalness of the landscape.

CASTELLO DI UVIGLIE - Rosignano Monferrato (Al)

The historical roots of the vineyards of Castello di Uviglie date back to 1491. Rich in this tradition and in an exceptional terroir characterized by solitary hills, white soils, and millennia-old underground quarries - now used as cellars -, the company is a dynamic production reality operating sustainably. The promise is to see Monferrato among the prestigious territories of Piedmont, safeguarding its native grape varieties such as Grignolino, Barbera, and Albarossa, alongside an excellent experimentation with Metodo Classico sparkling wine.

Four friends with a great passion for wine decide, among the desks of the enological school of Alba, to produce together a sparkling wine. The idea arises from the desire to create something unique and original with grapes different from the conventional ones. They carry out numerous sparkling wine trials starting from different bases with the aim of gaining familiarity with the method and finding the suitable grape variety to meet their expectations. These experiences lead them to identify Nebbiolo as the most interesting variety. Thus, Erpacrife is born.

STELLA - Costigliole d'Asti (At)

Located in the heart of Monferrato, one of the most renowned wine regions in the world, this company originated in 1920 thanks to Domenico Stella, also known as Giaiet. Some gold medals, received at the Turin Trade Fair in 1928, testify to its activity. Now the winery is run by Paolo and Massimo with the help of their father Giuseppe. It produces Grignolino, Freisa, but it is mainly Barbera that features prominently in its catalog.

For generations, the Mondo family has been cultivating Barbera vineyards in San Marzano Oliveto, in the heart of Monferrato. Valerio, accompanied by his father Franco and his daughter Beatrice, was one of the first interpreters of the Nizza DOCG. Established in 2014, the Nizza designation has elevated this area, with its great vocation for Barbera, to its own appellation.

GATTO Pierfrancesco - Castagnole Monferrato (At)

It was born at the end of the 19th century with grandfather Giacomo, who began vinifying the first Barbera grapes. Today, it extends across the hills of Castagnole Monferrato and Montemagno, cultivating Grignolino, Barbera, and Ruchè. The latter, almost disappeared, was saved thanks to grandson Pierfrancesco, who revalued this historical variety for solemn occasions and festivals, imported by Cistercian monks in other eras. His lands, of tufaceous origin and very sandy, receive minimal interventions, and even in the cellar, work is entrusted to nature and tradition. The wines thus faithfully mirror the terroir. Relics of a distant past.

ILARIA SALVETTI - Caluso (To)

Caluso is a small town in Canavese, a Piedmontese land nestled between the imposing moraine of the Serra di Ivrea and Lake Candia. For centuries, this land has been the treasure trove of a Piedmontese white grape, Erbaluce. The heart of the DOCG produced is in Caluso, where the most important crus of this denomination are located. Ilaria Salvetti is the third generation of winemakers dedicated to the cultivation of Erbaluce: since 2012, Ilaria, with determination, has decided to dedicate her life to enhancing this variety particularly suited to producing classic method sparkling wine and passito. Environmental sustainability is at the core of both vineyard and cellar work.

LA CHIMERA - Chiomonte (To)

The company is located in Val di Susa, where vine cultivation has always been practiced, now in the spotlight for other issues. Stefano Turbil works his vineyards, situated on old terraces above 700 meters above sea level and at risk of abandonment, with care and dedication. He is a full-fledged member of the small number of producers involved in the Vini Estremi project. He has rescued from extinction two historical grape varieties of the area: Avana and Becuet.

L'AUTIN - Barge (Cn)

Among the Piedmontese Alps lie two small valleys, the Germanasca and the Pellice. These mountains guard two treasures: in their heart, talc, and on the surface, the cultivation of the rare Bianver variety. Over the centuries, the inhabitants have become miners and have dug deep mines for talc extraction where, today, at 10°C and 90% humidity, Mauro and Elisa Camusso refine the sparkling wines produced. Mauro, an agronomist turned stone worker (not coincidentally, he has created a tank made of Luserna stone for refining passito), has passed on his love for viticulture to Elisa, who manages these vineyards at 400 meters above sea level, in the shadow of Monviso, with energy and passion.

Morgassi Superiore is located in the heart of the certified production area with the Gavi DOCG of the Municipality of Gavi. Founded by Marino Piacitelli in 1993, the company is now run by his daughters Marina and Cecilia, following a path of research to grow the winery through a combination of tradition with the most careful manual interventions and innovative technology, with an unwavering commitment to quality. The vineyards are situated on steep hillsides, facing south/southwest, with limestone-clay soils.

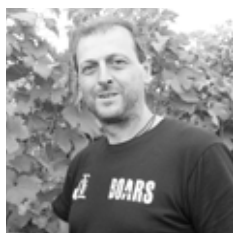


OTTOSOLDI - Serravalle Scrivia (AI)

The name of the Ottosoldi winery in Gavi means literally "eight shillings." The story goes that the grandfather of the current generation of owners purchased this gorgeous estate and top growing site with otto soldi or eight shillings that he had managed to save. Today, this boutique estate owns approximately five hectares that extend across an amphitheater vineyard with southwest exposure – one of the most coveted crus in the Gavi appellation. The entire parcel is planted to Cortese di Gavi, the native white variety used to produce Gavi wine. The soils in Gavi are rich in limestone and clay, ideal for the production of long-lived white wines, and the Ottosoldi property also benefits from the maritime influence of the Mediterranean Sea which lies just an hour or so away by car. The sea breeze helps to create diurnal shifts in temperature, warming the vines by day and then cooling them by night. As a result, the winemaker is able to preserve the freshness and natural aromas and flavors of the grapes during vinification.

The company, located in Canale, in the Madonna dei Cavalli hamlet, was founded by Oreste in the 1960s and is now managed by his son Fabrizio, who, together with Andreina, cultivates only historical grapes from their territory. The land is mainly composed of marine sands and gray-blue clays. Malinat, Giaconi, and La Rondolina are the names of the vineyards. Roero is part of the UNESCO World Heritage.

TACCHINO - Castelletto d'Orba (AI)

We are in the Alto Monferrato, in the municipalities of Castelletto d'Orba and Lerma, halfway between Gavi and Ovada, in the area most suited for the production of Dolcetto di Ovada, known as Ovada in its Superior version. The Tacchino family has been producing grapes and wine for three generations, but the leap in quality was made by the current generation, and it has been recognized both in Italy, with an impressive 9 Tre Bicchieri awards from Gambero Rosso for Du Riva out of the 13 consecutively received, and abroad. The gems of their production include Dolcetto: Tralci and Du Riva, Barbera: Tralci and Albarola, Cortese: Tralci Gavi from the municipality of Gavi, and Trivoli. TENUTE SELLA 1671 - Lessona (Bi)

In October 1870, Quintino Sella, the Minister of Finance of the Kingdom of Italy, celebrated the first government of national unity. For the occasion, instead of opening a bottle of champagne, as was customary throughout Europe at that time, he decided to toast with a bottle of Rosso Lessona from his family estates. The history of the Sella family intertwines with the Italian wine history over the last three centuries, and it is certainly moving to see bottles preserved in the cellars of the estate capable of preserving the time, thoughts, and efforts of generations of men and women who came before us. In 1671, Comino Sella acquired a vineyard in Alto Piemonte: in Lessona, a small wine-producing area historically dedicated to the production of high-quality red wines, the result of noble soils and sands from an ancient sea. For 350 years, the generations of the Sella family have carefully tended to the vineyards of their estates, guarding them jealously, well aware that they are part of the cultural heritage of the entire Italian wine history.

VIGNETI MASSA - Monleale (AI)

Vigneti Massa has always produced grapes that are present on the hills of Tortona: Barbera, Croatina, Freisa, Moscato, and Timorasso. Here, the dialect is spoken. This choice, which may seem to many to have gone against the grain in the 1980s, was, as Walter proudly asserts, the only choice that would have taken the company out of the rut and the only strategy to bring the 4,000 years of history of the Terre Derthona under the world spotlight. «If I had followed the flock,» Walter argues, «my territory would have remained the Cinderella of Piedmont, and my company would have become one of the many Harlequins of Italy.» Even the fifth generation, grandchildren Edoardo and Filippo, believe in transitioning to screw caps and support the current logic, initially seen as heretical choices by their uncle, with faith and determination, aware that today, for wine to remain at the forefront, in addition to the established ingredients—ripe grapes, common sense, and time—it needs a fourth factor: being obsessive about details in the vineyard and in the cellar. As for distribution, Walter firmly states, Proposta Vini takes care of that with conviction.

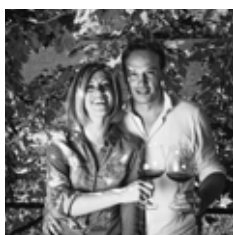

CEMBRA CANTINA DI MONTAGNA - Cembra (Tn)

The winemaking facility is located in the town of Cembra in the heart of the Cembra Valley, the Avisio river valley, a left tributary of the Adige which flows through the heart of Trentino-Alto Adige. The soil types in the valley's walls are predominantly volcanic in nature. As you drive up the steep road that leads through the valley, you can see the famous porphyry quarries, with their unmistakable reddish color.

The terraced vineyards, emblematic of mountain heroic viticulture, are the most explicit visual expression of the sacrifices and hardships involved in working in these rugged places, where access is only on foot and where work is done without mechanical means.

DE VIGILI - Mezzolombardo (Tn)

The De Vigili family comes from a long history of winemaking: until 1839, wine was commercialized with the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Wars interrupted the winemaking activity, and after over 70 years, Francesco, at just twenty-three years old in 2015, breathed new life into the family brand. The ideas are clear: the land must be cultivated without synthetic products and chemical herbicides, and in the cellar, the characteristics of the quintessential Trentino autochthonous grape, Teroldego, must be respected, aiming for elegance and drinkability. The Teroldego vineyards are located in the historic and original area of the grape: the Teroldeghe, a toponym dating back to 1490. A unique characteristic of the territory, of glacial and alluvial origin, is the concentration of alluvial sediments of granitic nature (Tonalite), the result of erosive action before the Adamello-Presanella glacier and afterward by the Noce river. Chardonnay, on the other hand, is cultivated in the Sorni di Lavis, in a limestone area that until 1980 housed a gypsum quarry. The grapes destined for the classic method come from vineyards that reach up to 750 meters in altitude. Following a significant renovation project, the company also aims to become an artistic, architectural, and cultural hub.

The same amazement applies to the Vino Santo Trentino, which is interpreted with a slight oxidation, as was done in past centuries.

VINDIMIAN Rudi - Lavis (Tn)

Rudi's family manages a small agricultural enterprise, cultivating vineyards between Lavis and Monte Terlago since 1880. Monte Terlago is in an alpine environment, at the foot of the Paganella mountain, at 780 meters above sea level, where the vines thrive in a wild setting visited by elusive foxes, agile roe deer, and even a greedy bear, immortalized while feasting on sweet grape leaves. In the vineyard, they follow biodynamic practices according to the guidelines, using nettle, horsetail, and chamomile decoctions. In the cellar, only indigenous yeasts are used, without enzymes or other additives, and a small correction of sulfur dioxide is made only at bottling.

ABBAZIA DI PRAGLIA - Teolo (Pd)

The Abbey of Praglia was founded between the late 11th and early 12th centuries, on the northern slopes of the Euganean Hills, along the ancient Montanara road that led from Padua to Este. The community of Praglia was entrusted by Pope Callistus II to the monastery of San Benedetto di Polirone, an eminent center of Cluniac observance near Mantua. The Benedictine Community of Praglia is currently the largest in Italy and counts around 40 members led by Abbot P.D. Stefano Visintin. As was generally the case for ancient abbeys, Praglia has also left its mark on the surrounding territory, significantly contributing to the construction of the agricultural landscape of the Euganean Hills, especially through the spread of viticulture and olive culture. An ancient cellar, cutting-edge technology, and utmost respect for the environment form the basis for wise viticultural management in the 21st century. The awareness of how good agricultural practices can respect the environment for the well-being of all leads to avoiding the use of chemical products as much as possible, firmly anchoring today's viticultural project to a wisdom that comes from afar.

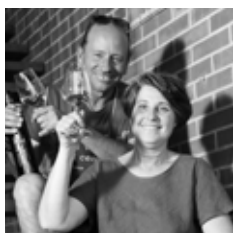


CAMORALI PIERLUIGI - Lugagnano val d'Arda (Pc)

Here are the elements of an adventure novel encapsulated in a bottle. Two young winemakers: Tiziano and Matteo, a genius namely Leonardo da Vinci, and three wines, Ortrugo, Gutturnio, and Malvasia di Candia, all set in a virtually unknown place: the Piacenza region. The hills of Val Chiavenna, a valley named after the river that runs through it, are shaped by layers deposited over a period ranging from five to about one and a half million years ago, in an arm of the sea that once connected with the present-day Adriatic. These hills are indeed part of the Piacenza Natural Geological Reserve. In centuries past, the Reserve and its fossils were studied by Leonardo da Vinci, who left his mark on them in 1482 in the Codex Leicester. LODI CORAZZA - Ponte Ronca di Zola Pedrosa (Bo)

Farming has been a family tradition for the Lodis, which continues today with siblings Silvia and Cesare. The history of the winery began in 1726 when the Papal States started to divest their Bolognese land holdings. The first document attesting to the production and sale of wine by the Lodis dates back to 1877. Cesare, who oversees the vineyards and wines, pays utmost attention to Pignoletto, a historic grape variety of the region, whose unique characteristics he believes should be highlighted. In terms of red grape varieties, his dedication to Barbera is particularly noteworthy. Barbera, a grape that appears throughout the Apennines, has ancient origins and is traditionally vinified as a sparkling wine in these territories.

LA PIANA - Castelvetro di Modena (Mo)

It is located on the lush hills of Castelvetro di Modena, where Cesare Gianaroli purchased a small plot of land back in 1951. The company's greatest pride is naturally the Lambrusco Grasparossa di Castelvetro: a variety very different from the Lambrusco varieties produced in the plains and, since 2020, guaranteed by the collective brand Montebarello 155. This ambitious project, of which La Piana has been one of the main supporters, sees the historic wineries of the province at the forefront and aims to enhance this grape variety by adopting a more restrictive specification compared to the existing D.O.P. regulation, which includes the mandatory transition to organic farming for all participating companies. The goal is to create a protected area where only virtuous and non-invasive practices are employed for the flora and fauna of the territory, with a focus on environmental sustainability.

TENUTA IL PALAGIO - Figline Valdarno (Fi)

The Palagio Estate is a vineyard located south of Florence on the hills of Tuscany. It overlooks the small towns of Figline and Incisa Valdarno. The estate was originally built in the 16th century. Today, it is owned by the singer Gordon Matthew Thomas Sumner, better known as Sting, and his wife Trudie Styler, who discovered it in the late '90s and rescued it from deterioration. The lands here, in the higher regions of Tuscany, are poorer and rockier, but they have a good water reserve. The Arno River valley serves as a temperature regulator, bringing in cool winds and nights to the area. Many wine producers in Tuscany are aware of these diverse growing conditions and often purchase grapes from this region. There are 11 hectares of vineyards on the property, cultivated using biodynamic methods.

TERRE NERE - Montalcino (Si)

Montalcino always surprises, both for its Sangiovese and for the women and men who produce it. The history of this winery dates back a long way: Mr. Vallone, in the post-war period, moved from the countryside of Palermo to the heart of Tuscany. It will be his son Pasquale who will build the cellar where grandchildren Francesca and Federico now oversee the winery located to the south-southeast of Montalcino, in the area of Castelnuovo dell'Abate, on the slope upon which stands the Castello della Velona. The soils are dark and are offspring of the ancient extinct volcano of Monte Amiata. In the cellar, Francesca is a staunch traditionalist, imposing long aging in large barrels on her wines, while in the vineyard, in order to promote biodiversity, she uses techniques such as the preservation of beneficial insects, mulching, green manure, fertilization with manure, and the use of natural products. All of this is done to maintain a relationship with the surrounding habitat.

TENUTA DI PIETRA PORZIA - Frascati (Rm)

The history of the Pietra Porzia Estate is closely linked first to the events of the Roman Empire, then to the Papal State and its immense properties in the Agro Romano. A few kilometers from the Eternal City, amidst the Alban Hills, along a splendid avenue of cypress trees stretching for almost a kilometer, one encounters, seemingly frozen in time, a villa and a cellar built in 1892, enriched by a large basin collecting water from a perennial spring. Above the caves of these springs lies a vineyard that occupies the area of the ancient Lake Regillo's amphitheater. At a depth of 15 meters, in the underground of the modern cellar, a cave preserves a series of galleries 400 meters long, carved into the tuff 2000 years ago. The original purpose of such a spectacular complex is unclear; it is hypothesized that the cave was once actually the terminal cistern of the aqueduct built by Emperor Claudius in the 1st century AD.

This harvest constituted the sole raw material for the production of Marsala wine, and today, in the same location, the current owners produce organic wines and have chosen to perpetuate the culture of the so-called "Perpetual" wine using the traditional production method of the area. The Ansaldi family, with great passion, has managed to blend the agricultural soul, consisting of vineyards, olive groves, citrus orchards, and almond trees, with the meticulously crafted Sicilian hospitality expressed in the expertly restored restaurant and accommodation facility.

The hardworking spirit of the Foti Family is tied to the pleasure of doing well, without frenzy, in harmony with oneself and the surrounding environment: the landscape, nature, the Etna volcano, of which they are a part, not above. I Vigneri is an organic system of viticulture respecting both humanity and the environment in which it operates. 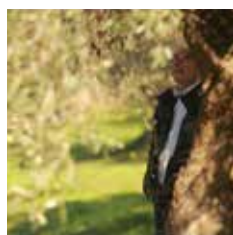


MURGO - Santa Venerina (Ct)

PANEVINO - Nurri (Ca)

This company is the epitome of the concept of daily celebration. The family was large, the vineyard was the focal point of everything, and every day at the table there were so many people, including family members and workers, that baking bread once or twice a week became necessary.
