Renewal

"Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect."

Romans 12:2

As a United Methodist Pastor, renewal is a term I often hear. The deep concern of burn-out is always there, so the Conference is sure to make us aware of the need for it. I know pastors who take a couple weeks every few years to go on a spiritual retreat, sometimes just sitting



in silence and meditating. I can think of few things I would hate more than this. I would go crazy! I do appreciate the need for renewal, but not just for clergy, but for everyone who carries the name of Christ. It is a difficult calling we have received, striving to live as Christ, growing in our understanding of God's will and teachings, while serving as the hands and feet of Christ can be overwhelming. But I think there is something worse that being overwhelmed and that is complacency and as we reach the end of the season of Lent, complacency is a good thing to consider.

Sometimes we find ourselves in a rut. Doing the same things over and over helps to create complacency. We start to forget or not realize the blessings and work that are going on around us. We start to take for granted the ease of things in our church. No arguing or talk of splits, no troublemakers complaining, which unfortunately is fairly common in many congregations. The growing number of kids we have been blessed with. So many churches do not have any children at all! For many, Sunday worship is just there. They do not think about all the people and parts that go into getting things ready, from paying the bills to making deposits, to cleaning and repairing, organizing and writing and printing.

The same is true when we worship. We have grown so accustomed to the Order, we fail to stop and think about what it all means, the words we sing, "Here I Am Lord, Softly and Tenderly Jesus Is Calling," do we really consider what we are saying and do we truly mean it? Or the Lord's Prayer, when was the last time we really thought about what we are saying?

Renewal is more than just leaving for a time or taking a break, it really about the way we think! "Discerning God's will" as Paul put it. Renewal is important, but it does not always come easy. It requires us to slow down, to appreciate, to look at things in a new way and a willingness to change.

As we come to the end of this season of Lent and anticipate the joy and Hope and Beauty of Easter, may we see with renewed eyes and a renewed spirit. May we be drawn closer to God and to each other as we move forward, living, serving and worshiping as the family of faith that God has blessed us with and called us to be!


Women's Ministry meeting for first time
