PROJECT OVERVIEW

BURNING is a black-and-white graphic novel for Young adult (Aged 13-18 yrs).

Actors will be filmed on green screen and selected still frames from the footage transformed into stylized line-art images and composited onto illustrated backgrounds.

PERFORMANCE STYLE & FORMAT

This is **not** a traditional on-camera acting role.

This project emphasizes **facial expression, posture, and controlled physicality** not spoken dialogue. Performances will need to translate clearly into static images.

We will be working rapidly to enact a large number of micro scenes or movements. Some of these will be in groups of 2 or 3 actors, some will be alone and then composited into larger scenes.

Experience in acting, modeling, movement, or dance is helpful but not required, but you must have a knack for expressing yourself with face or movement.

TIME COMMITMENT & LOGISTICS

- The number of filming sessions depends on how much that character is featured, but, except for a handful of lead roles, the commitment would typically be a couple of sessions
- Each session would be 4-6 hours. They would be scheduled on evenings and weekends with occasional midweek daytime work if schedules of participants allow.
- Filming would take place within a simple green-screen setup with minimal props.
- Those cast will need to provide some of their own basic wardrobe (guidance provided) with neutral, non-branded clothing. Other items will be provided.
- Those that take part acknowledge that they will be photographed, filmed, and transformed into illustrated or stylized images for use in a graphic novel project, including print, digital, online, and interactive editions of the work, as well as promotional materials directly related to the project.
- Performances and images will not be used to train or contribute to general artificial intelligence or machine-learning models.

COMPENSATION

This is a small, independent production.

- Actors will receive \$17 per hour of work, payable by Venmo or Zelle within one day of each session. Partial hours will be prorated.

AUDITION INSTRUCTIONS

Auditions are **prompt-based self-videos**.

You will be asked to use your smart phone to record a short sequence responding

physically and emotionally to some simple written prompts (e.g., suspicion, realization, fear, resolve). Each reaction should be held clearly so it can translate into a still image.

You will upload your auditions to an individual password-protected Google Drive folder for each person auditioning. The files will be deleted once casting is finished.

Detailed prompts will be included in the audition packet.
