STANDARD RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. **Dues.** Initial dues are \$5.00 per Member. The Club's Board of Directors can revise the annual dues at any time.
- 2. Ticket Sales. The Club sponsors frequent fund-raising events. Participation in the Club's fund-raising events is often limited due to the size of the available spaces for the events which requires the Club to sell tickets in advance of the event. Tickets are available in stages based on membership. With a limit of one (1) table per member. All names of persons, including guests must be provided to the Timber Pines Gen X Club, Inc on day of purchase. It is the purchaser's responsibility to advise the ticket holders of Agreement that is printed on back of ticket. A) The first day of ticket sales is open to Primary Members and Associate Members. B) The second day of ticket sales is open to Friends of Gen X. Thereafter, tickets are available to all TP Residents. The Club cannot guaranty that any tickets will be available after the first day of ticket sales. The Club's Board of Directors can revise the manner of ticket sales at any time. Excepted from this general policy are Singo and the Fourth of July Event for which tickets are sold on a "first come, first served" basis. And/or Director approval.
- 3. Check Approval. All disbursements must be approved as follows:
 - (a) Other than normal operating expenses as set forth in the Club's approved budget and expenses for talent, any expenditure exceeding \$500.00 must be approved by the Club's Board of Directors and entered into the board minutes.
 - (b) Talent expenditure exceeding \$2,600.00 must be approved by the Club's Board of Directors and entered into the board minutes.
- 4. **Member Comments at Member Meetings.** To ensure an orderly Member meeting, any Member who wishes to address the Board at a Member meeting:
 - a) Must advise the Secretary of the topic to be discussed no less than 48 hours prior to the meeting so the item can be included in the agenda.
 - b) Each Member will have up to three (3) minutes to present his or her comments to the Board. The Board may grant additional time to a Member to respond to Director questions.
 - c) The total period for all Member comments will be limited to fifteen (15) minutes. The Board may grant additional time for all Member comments.
 - d) No repetitive comments. For example, if a Member has made a comment on a specific topic, such as SINGO should be scheduled more often, additional comments stating the same point will not be accepted.

e) Conduct should be professional. The Board will not tolerate a Member who uses inappropriate language, launches a personal attack of a specific Director, Officer or Member, or otherwise exhibits unprofessional or disruptive behavior.
