 - Upon approaching Boulder City, at light, turn right at Veterans Memorial Dr 2.1 mi
 - Turn left at Commons Way, destination will be on the left 0.1 mi

TRIAL INFORMATION

If you need assistance or have questions, please ask any of the Smarty Paws trial representatives or the Trial Secretary. We want to make sure you enjoy your experience at our trial. Plenty of setup areas available on the grass, but canopies **cannot** be staked. Be sure to bring weights, or something to hold down your canopy as winds can get strong. Be prepared for walk thru in one ring while dogs are running in the other. Due to the number of entries and to keep the trial moving along within a reasonable timeframe, there may be some overlap where dogs are running in both rings. Please don't worry, we'll be flexible with conflicts, and everyone will get an opportunity to run.

Just a reminder lunches are **not** being provided, but water will be available.

- **Friday: *First Dog on the line at 10:00 am***
 - Exhibitors may begin setting up crating areas at 8:00 am.
 - There will be an **onsite briefing at 9:45 am**
 - We also recommend all exhibitors read the [NADAC Overview](#) that will be posted on the trial secretaries website RinoAgility.com/SmartyPaws-Feb-2023 and save this link to view course maps and trial results, etc.
 - Note for Volunteers; we need and appreciate your assistance throughout the event!
 - We can always use help with unloading and ring setup! (Bring gloves)
 - Filling tunnel bags is a critical task that takes some time but is easy to do!
- **Saturday/Sunday: *First Dog on the line at 9:00 am***

There will not be a formal **check in** process, but we do ask that each exhibitor check their dog(s) in on the gate sheet which will be posted before each class. Don't forget to validate information on your confirmation and email RinoAgility@gmail.com before the trial if there are any corrections needed. We will be accepting 'Day of Entries' at this event, until we reach the daily run limits. Watch the website for updates.

If your dog needs to be **measured**, you must ensure this takes place **prior** to your first run. The judge or a trial representative will be available prior to the morning walk throughs each day. We'll be happy to assist you throughout the day if you aren't arriving for the first class, but please don't wait until the last minute as we will need to work you in around the trial and judge's schedule. Come by the trial secretary table for assistance. Before getting measured you will need to fill out the "[Application for Permanent Height Card](#)" form. (We can also provide a blank form at the trial.) Note: If your dog is jumping 20" or you entered in the Skilled category you do not need to be measured.
