DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY Washington County Legacy Park 5500 W. 700 S. Hurricane, UT 84737

- From the South: Follow I-15 N to UT-9 E in Washington. Take exit 16 from I-15 N. Merge onto UT-9 E towards Hurricane. Turn right onto 5300 W. Continue straight onto 5500 W/S Regional Pk Rd
- From the North: Follow 15 S to UT-9 E in Washington. Take exit 16 from I-15 S. Merge onto UT-9 E towards Hurricane. Turn right onto 5300 W. Continue straight onto 5500 W/S Regional Pk Rd
- Notes for finding the arena: the first building you come to is holding a flyball tournament, just past the New Harmony building is the SUDS indoor arena. The indoor arena is near the outdoor horse arena and RV parking. There will be some signs pointing to 'SUDS NADAC' and signs will also direct you to the "Dry Camping" area which is across the street from the arena. If go past the DMV office on the corner, to a sign that says "overflow parking" that is the dry camping area. Directly across the street from there, turn left into RV parking and the indoor arena.

TRIAL INFORMATION

If you need assistance or have questions, please ask any of the SUDS trial representatives. We want to make sure you enjoy your experience at our trial. Please drive at a safe speed, stay, and park within the designated areas. Setup is available indoors, so canopies are not necessary. The arena is air-conditioned with AC (not swamp coolers), so although the temperatures outside could be a bit warm the arena should be comfortable!

- Friday: Exhibitors may begin setup at o8:00am (Exhibitors may arrive anytime for an RV site, but NO setups on Thursday.)
 - Briefing will begin at 09:45am we do recommend all exhibitors read the <u>NADAC Overview</u> that is posted on our trial secretary website <u>RinoAgility.com</u> and save this <u>link</u> to view course maps and trial results, etc. Results will be posted online, not printed. Individual results will be sent out after the event as well.
 - First dog on the line at 10:00am on Friday.
 - Note for workers/volunteers; we need and really appreciate your assistance throughout the event. Helping with setup and breakdown, plus volunteering in the ring helps keep the trial moving!
- Saturday/Sunday: First dog on the line at og:ooam.

There will not be a formal *check in* process. We do ask that each exhibitor check their dog(s) in on the gate sheet which will be posted before each class. Don't forget to validate information on your confirmation and email <u>RinoAgility@gmail.com</u> before the trial if there are any corrections needed.

If your dog needs to be *measured*, you must ensure this takes place *prior* to your first run. The judge or a trial representative will be available prior to the morning walk throughs each day. We'll be happy to assist you throughout the day if you aren't arriving for the first class, but please don't wait until the last minute as we will need to work you in around the trial and judge's schedule. Come by the trial secretary table for assistance. Before getting measured you will need to fill out the "<u>Application for Permanent Height</u> <u>Card</u>" form. Note: If your dog is jumping 20" or you entered in the Skilled category you do not have to be measured (yet). Skilled dogs can be measured throughout the weekend to meet the new NADAC measuring requirement which is effective Jan. 1, 2025.
