DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY

George Ingalls Equestrian Event Center 3737 Crestview Avenue, Norco, CA 92860 (Continue East on 6th Street past Crestview – Stay to Right)

Take I-15 to Sixth Street Exit. Proceed East on Sixth Street approximately 2 miles. Go past Crestview Dr. (do not turn on Crestview) and follow the road as it curves up around the corner to the right. Enter Gate # 1 and you will see the covered arena on the right.

- ➤ Very Important
 - Please use caution and keep an eye on your dogs, especially if camping or hiking in the hills, as there is wildlife (coyotes, owls, squirrels, snakes, etc.) in the area.
 - o Agility exhibitors do not take your dogs into the area marked for the equestrian event. Violators will be asked to leave the agility event with no refunds. (No Exceptions.) This will be strictly enforced to ensure we do not lose our access to the facility.

TRIAL INFORMATION

If you need assistance or have questions, please ask any of the Rino Agility Partners trial representatives. We want to make sure you enjoy your experience at our trial. Setup is available under the covered arena, so canopies are not necessary. Be prepared for action with both rings running simultaneously. The Elite level (and possibly the lower levels as well) will be split into two groups. You'll be assigned to either group A or B (and should be in the same group with all your Elite level dogs). For Elite we'll start the day in both rings. Walk, then Run Rd 1 and Rd 2 with one group in each ring, then switch and Walk, Run/Run in the second ring. For the 3rd class of the day both Elite groups will walk, then both will run Rd 1, then Rd 2. This will help keep the trial moving and hopefully avoid conflicts! Please don't stress, if you do end up with a conflict from volunteering or an assignment mistake, just let us know and we'll make sure it works out.

Note: We will <u>not</u> have our normal **Agility Videos 4 You** filming at this trial. We'll miss Alan and Kathy and their great videos and hope to have them back soon.

Kasey will be offering Canine Therapy again on Sunday from approximately 10am - 2pm, so let her know if you're interested. You can text her at 760-685-3134 or look at her flyer on our <u>Facebook</u> page for more info.

- Friday: Exhibitors may begin setup at 10:00am. (We need time before 10am to designate rings, trial secr, & exhibitor areas.)
 - No onsite briefing we recommend all exhibitors read the <u>NADAC Overview</u> that is posted on our website <u>RinoAgility.com</u> and save this <u>link</u> to view course maps and trial results, etc. Results will be posted online, not printed. Individual results will be emailed out after the event as well.
 - Walk Throughs will begin by 11:00am on Friday.
 - Note for volunteers; we need and appreciate your assistance! Equipment trailer is scheduled to arrive by 09:00am on
 Friday. (I shoot for 8:30am but depends on traffic!) Unloading and ring setup will begin shortly thereafter. (Bring gloves!)
- > Saturday/Sunday: Walk-throughs will start at og:ooam.

There will not be a formal *check in* process, but we have a goodie for each dog entered. We do ask that exhibitors check their dog(s) in on the gate sheet which will be posted before each class. Don't forget to validate information on your confirmation and email RinoAgility@gmail.com before the trial if there are any corrections needed.

If your dog needs to be *measured*, you must ensure this takes place *prior* to your first run. The judge or a trial representative will be available prior to the morning walk throughs each day. We'll be happy to assist you throughout the day if you aren't arriving for the first class, but please don't wait until the last minute as we will need to work you in around the trial and judge's schedule. Come by the trial secretary table for assistance. Before getting measured you will need to fill out the "<u>Application for Permanent Height Card</u>" form. **Note:** If your dog is jumping 20" or you entered in the Skilled category you do not **have** to be measured (yet). Skilled dogs can be measured throughout the weekend to meet the new NADAC measuring requirement which is effective Jan. 1, 2025.

FOOD

We will NOT be providing beverages, snacks, or breakfast items so please plan ahead. Bring water for yourself and your dogs!

<u>Lunches</u> will be provided from Sixth Street Deli. (If you're bringing a guest, we typically have plenty of lunches for them to grab one as well after the exhibitors. However, if you send me a quick note, I will include them in my counts to be sure.)


