

# NADAC Trial: March 14-16, 2025 Norco, CA



## DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY

George Ingalls Equestrian Event Center  
3737 Crestview Avenue, Norco, CA 92860

(East on 6th Street **turn Right on Crestview, immediately jog Left, then Stay to the Right, continue to Gate #7**)

➤ Take I-15 to Sixth Street Exit. Proceed East on Sixth Street for approximately 2 miles. We need to enter at the far south end of the facility rather than off 6th street as usual. Make a right on Crestview as you come up 6th and an immediate jog left, then right to drive across in front of the facility on Crestview. **Enter gate 7.** You will see the covered arena ahead on the left as you enter.

### ➤ Very Important

- Please use caution and keep an eye on your dogs as there is wildlife (coyotes, owls, squirrels, snakes, etc.) in the area.
- Agility exhibitors do not take your dogs into the area marked for the equestrian event. Violators will be asked to leave the agility event with no refunds. (No Exceptions.) This will be strictly enforced to ensure we do not lose our access to the facility.

## TRIAL INFORMATION

If you need assistance or have questions, please ask any of the Rino Agility Partners trial representatives. We want to make sure you enjoy your experience at our trial. Setup is available under the covered arena, so canopies are not necessary. Be prepared for action with both rings running simultaneously. As usual please take note of the run order and levels. Each day one ring will be starting with Elite, then Open, Novice. The second ring will be starting with Intro Regular, then Elite, Open, Novice. The subsequent rounds we will plan to start with Elite, however we may adjust and start with Open or Novice if Elite is still occupied in the other ring. We encourage everyone "all levels" to come out at the start of the trial. If you're not running or have time before/after your runs, we always need and appreciate volunteers to help leash run, set jump bars, etc. Please don't stress, if you do end up with a conflict from volunteering, just let us know and we'll make sure it works out and you get to run!

**Note: We will not have our normal Agility Videos 4 You filming at this trial, so be sure to bring your own filming options!!**

### ➤ Friday:

- **Note for volunteers:** we need and appreciate your assistance! Equipment unloading and ring setup will begin by 09:00am.
- Exhibitors may begin individual setup at **10:00am**. (We need time before 10am to designate rings & exhibitor areas.)
- No onsite briefing – we recommend all exhibitors read the [NADAC Overview](#) that is posted on our website [RinoAgility.com](http://RinoAgility.com) and save this [link](#) to view course maps and trial results, etc. Individual results will be emailed out after the event as well.
- **Check In/Measuring: 10:30am Friday** required if your dog needs to be measured (see "please read" note below.)
- Walk Throughs will begin by **10:50am** on Friday with first dog on the line at 11:00am.

### ➤ Saturday/Sunday:

- **Check In/Measuring: 08:30am Sat/Sun** required if your dog still needs to be measured (see "please read" note below.)
- Walk-throughs will start by **08:50am** with first dog on the line at 09:00am.

**PLEASE READ:** We will have a formal **check in** process for any dogs requiring measuring at this trial. We'll set up near the trial secretary booth. Please fill out and bring the "[Application for Permanent Height Card](#)" form with you. NADAC's new rule requires every dog to have a permanent height card, after the age of 2 yo. Entry confirmations will indicate "**Measure-in required? Yes**" if you need to be measured at the event. If it shows measure in required and you have a permanent height card please email a copy and we can update our files so you don't have to check in or be measured. (\*Note: I looked up each dog as your entries were input and I updated my database if NADAC had a permanent height card recorded for your dog at that time.)

If your confirmation says "**Measure-in required? No**" then you aren't required to check in and no further action is necessary. We do ask that exhibitors check their dog(s) in on the gate sheets which will be posted before each class. Don't forget to validate information on your confirmation & email [RinoAgility@gmail.com](mailto:RinoAgility@gmail.com) before the trial if there are any corrections needed.

## FOOD

We will **NOT** be providing beverages, snacks, or breakfast items so please plan ahead. Bring water for yourself and your dogs!

**Lunches** will be provided from Sixth Street Deli. (If you're bringing a guest, we typically have plenty of lunches for them to grab one as well after the exhibitors. However, if you send me a quick note, I will include them in my counts to be sure.)

- Saturday: Meat or Vegetarian Lasagna, with Salad, Garlic Bread and a Brownie

Subject to change by the Judge or Trial Committee, if necessary, to ensure trial efficiency or safety.

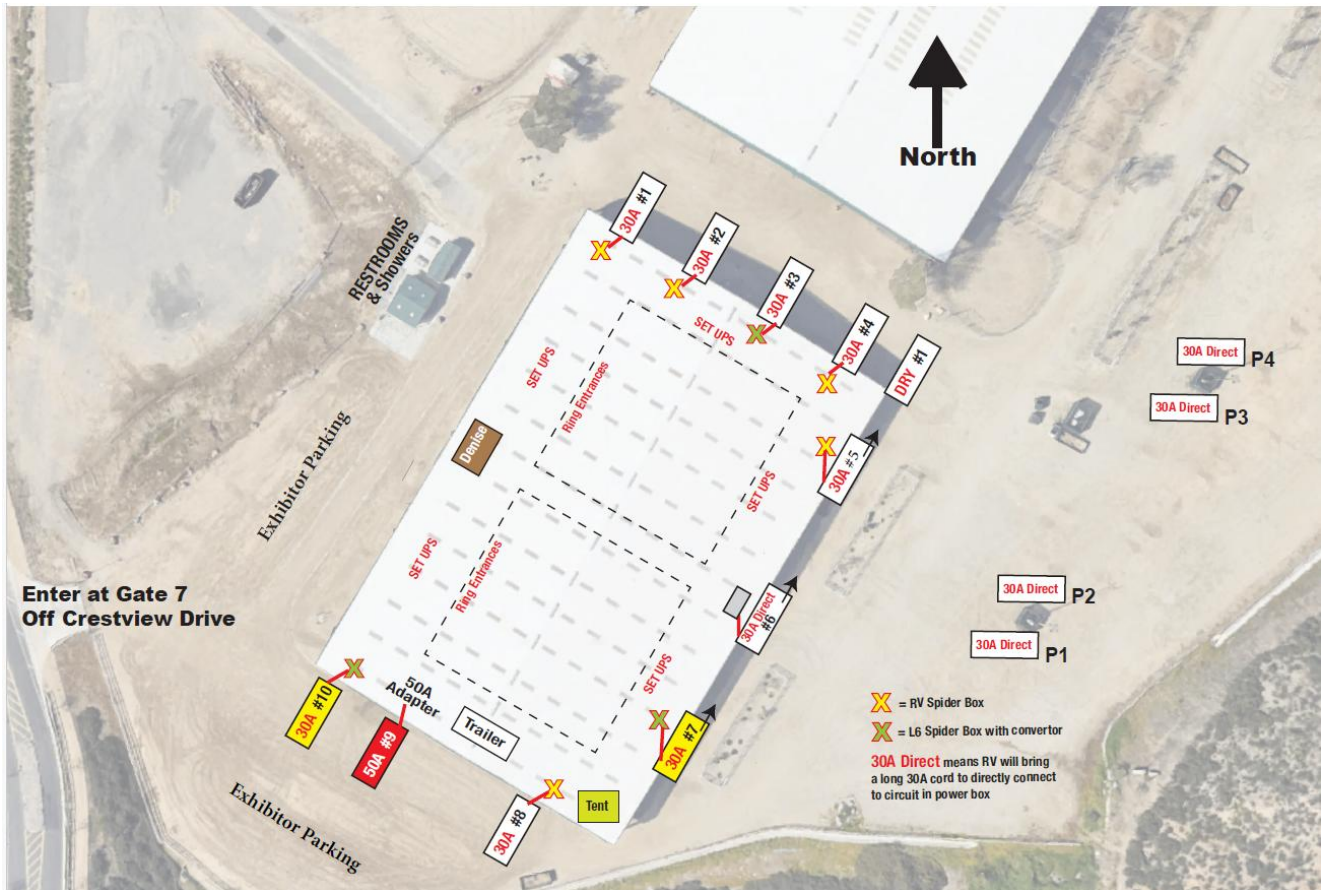

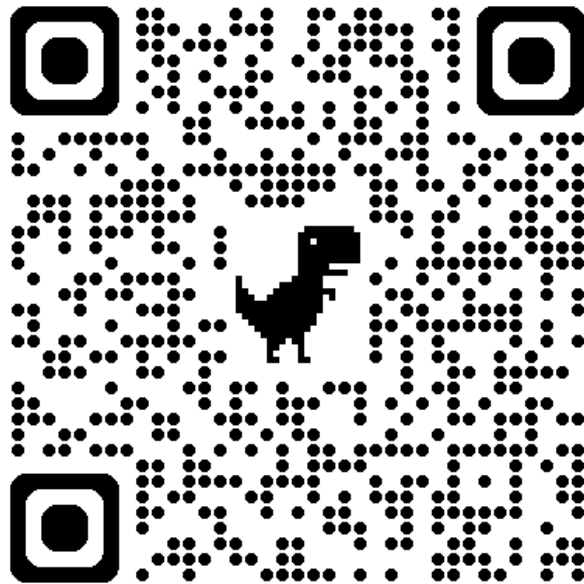
