End of Year Performance

Only students enrolled in classes for the season will be guaranteed to perform in the end of season performance. Drop-In students or students who are not enrolled September-June may be considered on a case by case bases. Students will be required to purchase costumes and possibly shoes. Costume invoices will be sent out in February. If a student drops a class after costumes have been purchased, they will still be invoiced for the costume. Students with multiple absences will be removed from pieces. Any students absent from classes during the 4 weeks leading up to the end of season performance may be removed from a piece. Students are required to attend all dress rehearsals.

Payment Policy

A registration fee of \$25, per new student and \$10 per returning student, is due at the time of registration. Registration fees are not refundable. Monthly tuition is due by the 5th of each month. A \$25 late fee will be added to your account if tuition is not received by the 5th. Individual monthly tuition will be communicated via email around the 15th of the prior month. If a student wishes to drop a class, an email must be sent before the 15th. Once invoices are sent out for the next month, they must be paid. After the 15th, any changes in tuition will be reflected on the following month's bill. Regularly scheduled private lessons will be billed with tuition for registered classes. Students who are not registered for a class will pay Drop-in rates. Drop-in fees are due

at the time of class. Class Cards must be fully paid for before they may be applied to a class. Class cards expire 60 days after the date of purchase.

Payments can be made in the form of cash, credit card, or personal check made out to Angela Fuller. If you prefer to pay bills online, you can with PayPal for a small fee. If your tuition is \$150 or less, a fee of \$3 will be added to your invoice. If your tuition is \$151-\$250, the fee will be \$5. If your tuition is over \$250, the fee is \$10. No refunds will be issued.

Missed Classes/Private Lessons Policy

Missed classes due to cancellation (weather, instructor illness or emergency) will be made up or refunded by a credit being placed on the student's account. If a student misses a regularly scheduled class due to a scheduling conflict, illness, etc, it will not be refunded. Private lessons cancelled with less than 24 hours notice will be refunded at 50% for the first three. If a student exceeds three cancelled lessons with less than 24 hours notice in the season (September-June), the cancelled lesson will not be refunded. If a student cancels a private lesson with more than 24 hours notice and the invoice (email stating amount due) has already been generated for that month, a credit for the private lesson will be applied to the student's account.

Putting Your Account on Hold

- 1.If you wish to place your account on hold (minimum of 3 weeks, maximum of 6 weeks, after which you must re-register and pay the \$25 Registration Fee), you must notify GADP in writing by the 1st of the month, prior to your absence.
- 2.If your account is on hold, you will not need to pay your monthly tuition.
- 3.There will be a \$15.00 fee added to your tuition for your first month back to the studio.

Covid-19 Precautions

The following Covid-19 precautions will be adhered to until further notice:

- Everyone will wash hands upon entering the building.
- Dancers will place bags/belongings in designated spots, 6 feet apart in the hallway.
- The barres, mats, or any shared equipment will be sprayed daily with Microban 24 hour disinfectant.
- Dancers will hold spacing at barre or center, staying 6 feet apart.
- Dancers will sign in before each class, verifying they meet the following Covid-19 requirements:
 - They have washed hands upon entering the building.
 - They are not currently and have not experienced symptoms of Covid-19 in the last 14 days.
 - They have not been exposed to anyone confirmed to have Covid-19, or anyone presumed positive in the last 14 days.

Dress Code/Code of Conduct

Dancer Code of Conduct

- Dancers are expected to attend class regularly and be punctual.
- Respect for teachers, parents and peers will be expected at all times. Dancers behaving inappropriately will be asked to leave the class, and parents will be contacted.
- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your class to warm-up and be prepared for class.
- Any student arriving late should enter the studio quickly and quietly so as not to disrupt the class.
- No outdoor shoes should be worn on the Marley floor. Please remove street shoes at the studio door.
- No running in the studios, touching mirrors or hanging on the barres.
- Dancers must adhere to the dress code listed on the Giving Arts Dance Project website for every class. Tights with large holes are not permitted.
- Sweat towels are recommended for classes intermediate level and above.
- Hair must be in a bun for all ballet classes and pulled back off the face for all other classes.
- Dancers must treat the studio as if it was their home. Clean up all messes and throw out any food or garbage in the many bins provided.
- No food is allowed in the Dance Studio. Snacks may be eaten in the hallway or kitchen. Please wash hands after eating.
- Water bottles are allowed and encouraged.
- Label all belongings.
- If at any time an incident occurs in class or at the studio that makes you uncomfortable, a dancers should bring it to the attention of the instructor, Angela Fuller, and parents immediately so it can be resolved quickly.
- Dancers should sign in before class begins on the appropriate role sheet.
- Bullying, harassment, or discrimination will not be tolerated.
- Dancers should notify the instructor before class begins if they need to leave class early.
- Dancers should arrive and leave in dance cover-ups, especially during cold weather, and dance shoes should not be worn outside of the building.
- Dancers must stay quiet while waiting in the hall prior to class. The studio door will be opened when the next class is allowed to enter.
- Dancer, if over 18, has submitted a completed Covid-19 Liability Waiver.
- Dancers are welcome to wear a face covering in class as long as it does not in any way distract them or make them feel faint or lightheaded. Per the WHO recommendation, face coverings are not required.
- Dancers will place bags on designated spots in the hall, 6 feet apart.
- Dancers must sign in before each class. By signing in dancers are verifying they meet the following Covid-19 requirements:
 - They have washed hands upon entering the building.

- They are not currently and have not experienced symptoms of Covid-19 in the last 14 days.
- They have not been exposed to anyone confirmed to have Covid-19, or anyone presumed positive in the last 14 days.

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

- Parent/Guardian will ensure that the student attends class regularly, in required attire and on time.
- Parent/Guardian will inform Angela Fuller promptly about absences, late arrivals, or the need to place an account on hold.
- Parent/Guardian will ensure student is picked up no more than 15 minutes after class ends.
- Parent/Guardian will encourage and help child to follow the student code of conduct.
- Parent/Guardian will help studio staff deal with disciplinary issues involving their child.
- Parent/Guardian will not interrupt classes while in progress, except in the case of an emergency. If there is an emergency, please call Angela Fuller at 650-759-5336.
- Parent/Guardian will ensure student understands the Covid-19 requirements.
- Parent/Guardian will will notify Angela Fuller immediately if their dancer shows signs of Covid-19 or has been exposed to someone presumed or confirmed positive for Covid-19.
- Parent/Guardian has submitted a completed Covid-19 Liability Waiver..
