For 16 years, Dickman served on the Trenton Board of Education, including three terms as its president during that span. A founding member of the TEF and a dynamic Trenton Rotarian, he and his wife Linda are active members of Faith United Methodist Church. All four of their children are THS graduates.

Lefevre has been immersed in the Trenton community for decades. Affectionately known as the “Voice of Trenton” for his voluminous emcee assignments at sporting events, parades and a wide range of community events. He served for more than 30 years on Trenton City Council, as well as assignments with the TEF Board and Trenton Rotary among others.

Shenton proudly served as a Spanish teacher at Trenton High School for 20 years, leaving an indelible mark on generations of Trenton students. Her impact reached far beyond the Spanish classroom. She was a mentor, encourager, and role model, who consistently showed her students they mattered. She continues offering her leadership and volunteer skills at Faith United Methodist Church, including serving as Chair of its Scholarship Program.
