- Take home reading books for students at Anderson School to improve early childhood literacy
- Physical training tracking software to be used in conjunction with the new physical training room at Trenton High School

The Spring 2018 Special Projects are:

- Black Out Bullying- a program to help eliminate bullying.
- Challenge Day- a program that builds empathy and inspires a school-wide movement of compassion and positive change by addressing personal issues such as cliques, gossip, rumors, negative judgments, teasing, harassment, isolation, stereotypes, intolerance, racism, sexism, bullying, violence, suicide, homophobia, hopelessness, apathy, and hidden pressures to create an image, achieve or live up to the expectations of others.
