

NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILL CITY COUNCIL VACANCY BY APPOINTMENT

The City of Kinross, Keokuk County, Iowa, will have a vacancy on the city council as of August 11, 2026, due to the resignation of council member Leah Mast.

Pursuant to Section 372.13, (2), (a) of the Code of Iowa, notice is hereby given that the City Council of Kinross, Keokuk County, Iowa, intends to fill this vacancy by appointment during their next regular city council meeting that will be held at Kinross city hall at 7:00 PM on Tuesday, September 8th, 2026. However, the electors of the City of Kinross have the right to file a petition requiring that the vacancy be filled by a special election. If electors wish to require a special election, a valid petition requesting a special election must be filed with the city clerk within fourteen days after publication of this notice or within fourteen days after the appointment is made. If no such petition is filed, the appointment shall be for the period until the next pending election as defined in Section 69.12 of the Code of Iowa.

Eligible electors of the City of Kinross, Keokuk County, Iowa, wanting to be considered for appointment should submit a request in writing to the city hall by 4:00 PM on Thursday, September 3rd, 2026.
