The following pages are a comprehensive guide to help sellers prepare items for the sale. It includes instructions on using The My Sale Manager Program for inventory entry, tag printing, and post-sale reports. Also included are sizing instructions, pricing suggestions, preparing your items for sale, and our list of Acceptable and Unacceptable items for each seasonal sale.

Even if you are a returning Seller, please take the time to review these instructions as Tykes & Teens makes changes after every sale to keep the sale as current as possible.

Thank you for choosing Tykes & Teens Consignment!!

Key Takeaways for Selling:

- *NEW* for Fall / Winter 2026: T&T will be offering FREE tag printing on or before July 5th!! We will be at the mall location on July 5th to hand out your tags. If you have your items entered before that date, we can make arrangements to get them to you sooner. Need more time than that? We will offer tag printing for \$5 between July 6th and July 25th. Again, we will be at the mall location on various days during this time to get you your tags. You can still print your own tags... Just make sure they are clear and scannable.
- Also *NEW* for Fall / Winter 2026: T&T is going to implement color coding of seller tags to expedite the breakdown process. We ask sellers to highlight the words “Tykes & Teens” on their tags prior to tagging your items. Don’t have the color we ask for? We will have highlighters available at check-in for use. We will ask sellers to highlight their tags before leaving. **See our website for picture examples.** The color coding is as follows:
 - 1000’s = Purple
 - 1100’s = Green
 - 1200’s = Pink
 - 1300’s = Yellow
 - 1400’s = Blue
- T&T is now accepting either wire OR plastic hangers!! We just ask that whichever type of hanger you use (you can even mix and match), the items are secured onto the hangers to prevent sliding / falling / bunching.
- Each seller is guaranteed 200 items to be entered into the sale. Item limits only apply to shoes and books.
- The database closes the MONDAY of SALE WEEK! This is a MSM function and cannot be overwritten or changed by T&T committee members.
- Tags can still be printed after the database closes. No changes to items entered can be made after that time.
- Check and item pickup: Saturday from 5:30pm – 6:00pm or Monday from 5:00pm – 7:00pm.
- Wednesday Early Shopping: 5pm – Volunteers; 6pm – Sellers; & 7pm – Presale Registrations.
- Sellers that work a special 3-hour shift have the choice to receive either an increase in their sale percentage or a \$25 gift certificate to use at the sale. Special work shifts times are clearly indicated on the volunteer portal: Tuesday 5pm-8pm; Thursday 3pm-6pm; or Saturday 1pm-3pm. Each shift worked will increase a seller’s percentage by 5% (cap at 10% increase).
- T&T still starts sellers’ earnings at 70% of their sold amount.

INFANT / CHILDREN SIZING GUIDE

The size listed on your consignment tag must match the size on the clothing tag with the following rules: For the Tykes & Teens item tags, **CHILDREN's** clothes (think newborn to size 18/20) will have **NUMBER** value and **JUNIOR** clothes will be a **LETTER** value.

Please use the below charts for creating your tags & converting clothing sizes that do not match these criteria.

Remember: Clothing mis-labeled will **not be placed** on the correct rack & has a risk of not selling.

Infant Sizing

Use the Category ***"Infant Clothing"***

Infant Clothing = 0 – 24 Months

Choose either Infant Girl or Infant Boy

Children Sizing

Use the Category ***"Children Clothing"***

Children Clothing = 2 / 2T – 18 / 20

Choose Children Girl or Children Boy

Remember: Clothing mis-labeled will **not be placed** on the correct rack & has a risk of not selling.

Choose either **Junior Girl** or **Junior Boy**

Tykes & Teens also has the right to refuse any Junior Clothing items that are not from a Children's Clothing line. See the "Accepted Juniors Labels" under the "Acceptable Items" list.

Using My Sale Manager

Registering to Sell with Tykes & Teens

Use the links on the website, <https://tykesandteensconsignment.com> to obtain a new seller number or to activate your previous seller number(s). Payment for the Seller Number is due at the time of registration and this fee is **non-refundable**. Tykes & Teens has the right to limit the number of sellers for any sale. Sellers are guaranteed 200 items per seller number. If you wish to sell more than 200 items, you are welcome to purchase a second Seller Number. Each seller number requires a different email address. This is a My Sale Manager program requirement and not a T&T policy.

Entering Your Items

Use the link on our website or provided in the confirmation email from My Sale Manager to sign in to the My Sale Manager site. Check your JUNK folder if you are not receiving emails from us. Make sure to allow emails from My Sale Manager to stay up to date with sale notifications and information. ****Photos available on our website of the following steps****

Click on the **MENU** button. Select *“Work with Consigned Inventory”*. If you are a returning Seller, unsold and non-donated inventory items can be moved from *“Inactive Inventory”* to *“Active Inventory”*. Items can be edited once they are *“Active”*. Sold items should have automatically been removed from your inventory list.

To enter a new item into your *“Consigned Inventory”*, select *“Add Item”*. The MSM program will automatically assign your item a number. If you are a Returning Seller and have previously entered items into MSM, the numbers will continue to increase and MSM will not re-assign inventory numbers.

Choose the **Category**:

For CHILDREN's clothing:	Children Clothing Girls or Children Clothing Boys
For JUNIOR clothing:	Junior Clothing Girls or Junior Clothing Boys
For OTHER items:	Scroll through the various Categories and choose appropriately.

Choose the **Size**:

Use the size conversion chart under **“Sizing Guide” (previous pages)** to choose the correct size description.

For SHOES:	Infant	Infant Shoes Girl or Infant Shoes Boys (sizes 0 to 5)
	Toddler	Toddler Shoes Girl or Toddler Shoes Boys (sizes 4 to 9)
	Children	Children Shoes Girls or Children Shoes Boys (sizes 10 to 13)
	Youth	Youth Shoes Girls or Youth Shoes Boys (sizes 1Y to 5.5Y)
	Junior	Junior Shoes Girls or Junior Shoes Boys (sizes 6 to adult 13)

For TOYS: See options under the dropdown.

For ALL ELSE: Choose appropriate size from the dropdowns or Leave Blank (describe the item's details in the description lines).

Enter the **Description**:

Be as specific as possible. Use the Brand, Color, Design, Unique feature, etc. Tags can fall off during the sale. If your item does not have a tag, it cannot be sold. The better the description, the easier to reunite a lost tag with its item. We have numerous items that are brought to us by a potential buyer with no tag. That is money not going into your pocket. If we can look up the item by a description, then we can re-print the tag and sell the item.

Enter the **Price**:

Price must be in whole dollar amounts. See **“Pricing Suggestions”** for ideas and best practices. Minimum price is still \$1!! Some items (like onesies and books) sell better when grouped with like items. Consider this.

Enter the **Quantity**:

If you are selling multiples of the EXACT SAME ITEM, then you can enter the quantity of the items here. MSM will create an individual ticket for each of those items.

Check if the item can be **Discounted** = Item will be offered at 50% off during half-price shopping hours on Saturday.

Check if the item can be **Donated** = Item will be given to a charitable organization if not sold.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE ENTERED BY NOON THE MONDAY OF SALE WEEK!

Tags can still be printed after this time, but no changes can be made to your inventory items. Tykes & Teens has the right to refuse any tags with handwritten alterations.

Inventory & Tags

INVENTORY

- If you are a returning seller, those items from previous sales that did not sell and are **appropriate** for this next sale, can be easily activated for the current sale. There is no need to re-print a tag UNLESS you have made any changes. **Please note: make sure your tags from previous sales match the current Category and Sizing Guidelines.** If they do not, please re-print the tag with the correct modifications.
- There are many options for categories of items. Tykes & Teens use these categories to help place your item in the best possible location during the sale. If your item is in the appropriate location, it has a greater chance of selling. Please select a category that is as appropriate as possible. Remember to use the “**Sizing Guide**” on the previous pages to ensure your items are placed in the appropriate location during the sale.
- MSM allows you to enter your items in any order you wish. Tykes & Teens asks that you bring your items for check-in sorted by gender with like sizes grouped together. This not only assists with the check-in process but helps place your items in the proper location on the sale floor.
- If you choose to donate an item, it will automatically discount the item to be sold for 50% during half price shopping hours on Saturday. **Remember, donated items are tax-deductible and are put to very good use!**
- Be conservative when pricing your items. **Use the rule of thumb, what would I pay for this item if I was looking to buy?** Many shoppers will pick the lesser priced item of two items in similar condition. Most sales recommend pricing an item 1/3 of the new price if in mint condition and 1/4 of the new price if in fair condition. Price items in whole dollar amounts only.
- **Items should be free of stains, rips, holes, tears, snags. Items should not be missing buttons or have non-working zippers. Clothes should smell clean and be smoke, mildew, mothball, and pet order free.**
- Every sale there are items brought in that would have not been returned or could have sold if they had been washed or spot cleaned. Please consider this when prepping your items. We want you to be as successful as possible. The better the condition your items are in, the more likely they are to sell.
- Tykes & Teens reserves the right to refuse or reject any item that does not meet the criteria set forth in this guide.

TAGS

- **Per the seller agreement, tags MUST be printed on white cardstock.** If they are not, your items can be rejected, or the seller will be asked to re-print their tags on cardstock & re-tag their items. The lightest weight cardstock will be sufficient. Cardstock can be found on Amazon or at Walmart. If you have a friend consigning, you can split a pack. The barcode system used by MSM ensures an easy check-in & check-out process during the sale.
- It is important you print on a LaserJet printer and not on an ink-jet printer. With the barcode system, ink-jet printers can cause the barcode to bleed or become smeared. This will produce tags that cannot be scanned.
- To print, click on the “Menu” button of your consignor homepage and select “Work with Consigned Inventory”.
- Use “Print Tags”. There will be three options: Print Selected Tags; Print All Tags (HTML); and Print All Tags (PDF). If you have not printed any tags, select the Print All Tags option. If your printer is ready to go, you can choose either option. If you need to save your tags and then print from another printer, choose the PDF option so you can save the tags & print later.
- MSM also gives the option to select certain tags to print. If you are a Returning Seller & elect to move items from Inactive Inventory to Active Inventory, you do not need to print new tags (unless you have made a modification to the tag information or the sizing information is not in the current format). MSM remembers the tag has already been printed. If you choose the option for “Print unprinted Tags”, only the tags that are new or have been altered will show up for printing.
- When you print, **DO NOT** make any changes to the printer settings. This can cause your tags to print incorrectly. Do not change the font or size. Do not bold your tags. **Be sure your printer is NOT set to print double sided.**
- If you are using a printer that you have not used before, consider printing one page as a test to ensure the tags print correctly, the ink is dark enough, and the barcode is clear.
- Be careful when cutting your tags. Cut on the lines to make sure you do not cut off part of the barcode.
- Do NOT smear the barcode or allow the barcode to get wet.
- **Tykes & Teens reserves the right to either ask a Seller to re-print tags that cannot scan or reject the items with a barcode that cannot scan.**
- **See the new color-coding system on the front page. Ensure your tags have the correct color highlighting.**

Please note: if you are inactive for more than 20 minutes after logging into your Consignor Homepage, your session will time out & you will need to log back into the system to continue. If possible, have as many items ready to enter as you can when you begin entering your inventory. Nothing is lost. It is just easier if you don't have to log back in!

Preparing & Tagging Your Items

Please refer to the “Seller Instructions” tab on the website for pictures & descriptions detailing the best way to hang and tag your items. New pictures & instructions are added frequently.

Clothing

Tykes & Teens Consignment accepts children’s clothing from premie to Junior sizes. See the list of acceptable Junior Brands under “**Acceptable & Unacceptable Items**”. Clothing that is not a “junior brand” or something a teenager would wear, will be rejected. The sale also accepts shoes from infants to Junior 13. Only include clothing & shoes that are seasonally appropriate for the sale. Items that are not seasonally appropriate will be rejected during check in.

ONLY BRING CLOTHES YOU WOULD BUY! DO NOT BRING US ITEMS YOU WOULD NOT GIVE A BFF!

Remember, there is a *maximum of 10 pairs of shoes* per seller number.

Shoes must be in good to great condition. Shoes with stains, rips, tears, mud, or excessive wear **will** be rejected.

- Hanging items can be on wire OR plastic hangers. If your item is new on a plastic hanger, you can leave the item on that hanger BUT you MUST secure the item to the hanger. Wire hangers sometimes can be found at dry cleaners for free (Lexington ones seem to have them). But it is becoming harder to find them, so we have made the decision to use both types of hangers to make selling easier for everyone.
- All clothing must be freshly laundered & not smell of smoke – pets – mildew. NO PET HAIR!
- NO stained, torn, or badly worn clothing will be accepted. **WE MEAN THIS!!** Check your buttons & zippers!!
- Hang clothing **ON** the hanger with the hook pointing away from the tag. **The hook should look like a question mark (?)**. Join “Sellers Group” on Facebook & use the “Seller Instructions” tab on our website for pictures and descriptions detailing the best way to hang most items. Pictures are updated regularly.
- The tag should be pinned, with a safety pin, to the front **left** shoulder of the garment (think over the logo). Safety pins go straight across (not up & down). The safety pin should go on the tag through “Pin Here”.

Shirts: Hang ON the hanger & secure with pins. The hanger is **THROUGH THE SLEEVES**. EVEN INFANT!

Pants: Safety pin the waist band to hangers (do not fold over the hanger). To keep larger sized pants on hangers it is useful to pin the pants on either side of the hook and then add an additional pin to each end.

Clothing sets: **SETS MUST BE THE SAME SIZE!** Pin together & use only one tag and one hanger per set. Do not tape hangers together. Place the shirt on the hanger first, with the hanger through the sleeves. EVEN Infant clothes will have the hanger through the sleeves of one item. If the second item is a pant, pin the waist band of the pants to the top part of the hanger on the back side of the shirt. **Do not place a shirt under another garment.** We know this makes outfits look cute BUT the buyer should be able to see both items easily. Pin the pants to the shirt & hanger. This prevents damage to the clothing if pulled. The set can be different brands BUT it must be of the SAME SIZE.

Multiple items: More than one clothing item can be sold together on one hanger for one price. For example, two or three onesies can be hung on one hanger. When hanging multiple items, place one of the items on the hanger first (hanger through the sleeves) & then pin the other items to the top of the hanger on the back side. **These items can be different brands but all items must be the same size.**

Shoes: *NEW* for Fall / Winter 2026: Shoes can be packaged in a plastic bag OR zip-tied! ALL shoes brought to the sale must be clean, dry, & in good/great condition. Again, IF YOU WOULD NOT GIVE IT TO YOUR BFF, DO NOT BRING IT TO SELL. For shoes in bags (think infant shoes and shoes that cannot be zip-tied), the tag must be taped or pinned to the **inside** of the bag. **The bag must be sealed with clear packing tape (NOT Scotch Tape)**. DO NOT put the tag under any logos on the plastic bag. Large sized bags for Junior shoes can be found at most stores (2.5-gallon size are sold at Target, Walmart, Meijer, & Amazon). Do not include boxes with new shoes. Place the word “NEW” in the tag description instead. If you zip-tie the shoes together, be sure to place the zip-tie where it will not harm the shoes. Consider using packing tape to reinforce the tag before you attach it to the shoes. This will ensure your tag is not separated from your item, preventing the shoes from being sold. If the barcode is not easily readable, bent, or wrinkled, the item will be rejected as it cannot be easily scanned.

Many items sell better when hanging versus in a plastic bag. Consider hanging items like bedding, baby blankets, burping cloths, backpacks, scarves, & baby carriers.

Please use larger sized safety pins for multiples, jeans, Junior pants, or other heavy & thick items.

Present your item as if you would be looking to purchase the item at the sale.

Items hung or packaged nicely sell better.

Other Helpful Tips

- For toys with pieces, if there is a main part of the toy & also accessories / pieces to go with it, put the pieces in a plastic bag and attach them to the larger toy. Note on your tag the toy comes with “pieces”, “characters”, or “accessories”. Tape or zip-tie the bag to the larger / main toy.
- Books can either be placed in a plastic bag, wrapped with saran wrap, or be bare. **The Seller accepts the responsibility that books not in a plastic bag or wrapped could be damaged during the sale. ** T&T is not responsible for damage to books not protected in some way. Please see the pictures under “Seller Instructions” on our website for examples.
- Consider putting multiple books in one bag for one price. Grouped books tend to sell better. Ensure grouped books are of the same reading level.
- If taping a tag directly to an item, ensure the tape will not damage the item when / if removed.
- Avoid taping tags on items in a way that could cause damage to the tag & the barcode.
- Shoes not placed in a plastic bag will most likely be tried on. Remember this when attaching your tag. Again, items without tags cannot be sold and you do not make money.
- Accessories like clutch purses, wallets, children’s jewelry, hair bows, baseball hats, cell phone accessories, socks, & children’s underwear should also go inside a plastic bag. Put the tag inside the bag – either taped or pinned to the bag – so it does not move.
- Hang and pin crib linens, comforters, blankets, backpacks & baby carriers. Make sure the hanger is strong enough to hold the weight of the item. The items MUST be pinned to the hanger and MUST NOT MOVE. For items like blankets, hang the blanket over the bottom of the hanger and pin the blanket beneath the hanger bottom. This ensures the blanket will not move during the sale. See the pictures on the website under “Seller Instructions” for examples.
- Please look at your items under good lighting and perform a sniff test. Consider a quick wash or good soak for those less than stellar clothing items, a good wipe down of that toy, wash the car seat cover, wash the swing cover, take a magic eraser to those shoes, fluff the blanket, look for spit-up stains or blowout stains on those items belonging to the little ones, & check for missing buttons or broken zippers.
- When placing toys or games in the sale, please ensure you have the correct pieces to the toy or game. Consider if your toy or game could be considered a collector’s item to others. If so, be sure to include the exact contents OR indicate on your tag the game will have “like items” or “similar items” to what is listed on the packaging.

For ALL items placed in a plastic bag, the tag must be tapped or pinned to the inside of the bag. The bag must be sealed with clear packing tape (NOT Scotch Tape). DO NOT put the tag under any logos on the plastic bag.

FOR ANY ITEM:

Do not pin through the barcode.

If the barcode is not easily readable, bent, or wrinkled, the item will not scan.

During the Sale

One of the benefits of using My Sale Manager is you can keep track of your inventory during the sale. At the end of each night, Tykes & Teens will update the MSM program. Sellers can log into their Consignor Homepage to see which items have sold. Choose “View Your Sold Items” at the bottom of the page.

The “Estimated Earnings” on your consignor homepage is based on the default 70%. If you are part of our Tote Service you will only be receiving 50% of your earnings. Sellers who volunteer during the special shifts will receive 75% or 80% (depending on the number of designated volunteer shifts). These differences are calculated in our final reconciliation on Saturday afternoon, after the sale closes. Your final total will be reflected in your “Seller Report” that is posted to your consignor homepage on Saturday afternoon.

Something to Consider

30% of the items in the Spring / Summer 2026 sale sold as discounted on Saturday. When you are pricing your items, consider marking the item as discounted (half price) on Saturday.

Did you know?

Your seller fee & the % T&T takes from your sales are all tax deductible. All donated items are also tax deductible. Sellers receive a “Donated Items Report” at the end of the sale that can be used for tax purposes.

Fall / Winter Acceptable Items

Toys- Infant toys, educational toys, play jewelry, stuffed animals that have a talent (sing, dance, move, talk, interact), Nerf toys, light sabers, action figures, rugs with a children's theme, fall / Christmas / holiday themed toys, large electric toys (only if they have their charger, battery, and are in working condition).

Electronics / Gaming- DVD / Blu-Ray rated G, PG, or PG-13 (limit 25), video games rated E for Everyone or T for Teen, retro & current gaming systems with all cables and/or controllers, gaming accessories, clocks, speakers, gaming chairs, LED room lights, cell phone accessories (cases, chargers, wristlets), computer accessories, tablet / tablet accessories, youth or teen themed room decoration lights.

Books- Limit of 15. Children's books, junior books, maternity books.

Infant Clothing- Preemie outfits, all onesies (short or long sleeve), infant fleece, pants, shorts, sleepers.

Children's Clothing- Short sleeve & long sleeve button-down dress shirts, boys' suits, sports jerseys, dance wear, jeans, windbreakers, school uniforms, khakis, scout uniforms, short sleeve & long sleeve t-shirts, short sleeve & long sleeve polo shirts, athletic shorts (nylon, cotton, fleece, or dri-fit with elastic or drawstring waist), golf shorts / pants, athletic pants (all material including fleece), skirts, dresses, holiday dresses, robes, baseball hats, wearable sporting gear, fashion scarves, tights, leggings (please hang), sweatshirts / hoodies, PJ sets, PJ one-piece, new / gently used underwear, new / gently used socks, neck ties, winter hats / coats / gloves, snow bibs / pants / boots. ***We accept Boutique brand clothing!***

Junior Clothing- ALL types listed under Children's Clothing &: Junior Girls pants size 00-17, Junior Girls tops size XXS to XL, Junior Girls dresses, Junior Boys pants size 26-40 waist, Junior Boys shirts XS to XXL, belts, new / gently used socks, baseball hats, neck ties, bow ties, formal wear that is priced \$50.00 or less (hang in a dry cleaner bag / clear bag), hats, gloves, scarves. **See Acceptable Brand List below.**

Shoes- Limit of 10. Clean tennis shoes, rain boots, hiking boots / shoes, cleats, loafers, dress shoes, slides, snow boots, boots, UGGs, flats.

Games / Crafts / Puzzles- MUST have all pieces and be of a children or teen theme. Pokémon cards, Yu-Gi-Oh! cards, other trading cards / games. If the game requires batteries, those must be included.

Sporting Equipment & Sports Accessories- Items for toddler, children, and teens.

Large Play Items- Large outdoor play houses, play sets, art easels, children & toddler table / chairs, doll houses, children / toddler picnic tables, kitchen sets (including play food / pots & pans), sleds, bouncy seats.
