A representative from the Monroe County Community College will be here to provide help on how to fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

- Submit the FAFSA online at www.fafsa.gov
- Create a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID). Students and parents of dependent students must have an FSA ID in order to electronically sign the FAFSA.

They will also be able to answer questions on different types of financial aid such as;

Grants - Grants are awarded based on financial need and require no repayment. Both federal and state grants are available.

Loans - Loans must be repaid at a future date, with interest.

Work Study - Work study is a form of need-based federal financial aid. Work study provides students with part-time employment opportunities in a variety of on and off-campus jobs.

Scholarships - Monroe County Community College offers a variety of scholarships based on many different factors for students. Some factors may include academic achievement or financial need. No repayment is required for scholarships. The general scholarship application period is December 1st - March 1st.
