Good Evening Eagle Nation:

Tonight, the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services enacted Epidemic Order 333.2253. This order limits in-person instruction for high school students. Given our current spikes of students and staff being quarantined PK-12, along with this current order, **we will be suspending in-person instruction for all students beginning Wednesday, November 18, through December 8, 2020.**

Please note this important information:

- Starting Wednesday, November 18th, all Mason Consolidated School buildings will be **closed for in-person instruction.**
- Remote instruction **for all students** will begin Wednesday, November 18th.
- Building principals will send out additional detailed information for their respective buildings on daily schedules and resources needed for transitioning to remote learning. This will include information for students with an IEP or 504 as well.

We will reevaluate our learning plan prior to December 8th to determine the appropriate instructional delivery model going forward. To allow us to make an informed decision, please contact your child's building principal to inform them of any positive COVID-19 results or quarantine.

Remote learning is challenging and relies on a strong partnership between school and home. It is imperative that students engage during this time and that families support the online model as much as the in-person instructional model we have. The expectations will be much different than what we experienced last spring; attendance will count, completion of work will count, and engagement will count. Please make sure your child is prepared, engaged, and asks for help as needed.
