## Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2018-19 educational progress for the Mason Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2018-19 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Mason Middle School has not been given one of these labels.

Our index rating, delivered by the Michigan Depart of Education (in the winter of 2020), was an 81.17. We continue to focus on increasing achievement scores and closing the learning gaps of our most at-risk students. We provide several interventions supports throughout the day that support re-teaching, pre-teaching and supplemental instructional practices. We utilize state and local data to identify students' areas of need and utilize time and resources to supplant instructional practices. Our recent initiatives continue to focus on closing the achievement gaps of our students and providing more social and emotional resources for our students.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

1. PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL: Students who attend Mason Middle School come directly from our Central Elementary building, via

transfer, or are accepted as a School of Choice student from neighboring districts.

- 2. THE STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN. The school Improvement Plan continues to be modified to meet the curricular demands for our district. Based on our student achievement data, the need to align our curriculum district wide has become the biggest priority. We have been working with a consultant from the MDE to help align and provide professional development in the area of curriculum and instruction. We have currently completed Phase 1 of our PD plan by providing district PD days for our teachers to collaborate on and create an effective and transparent curriculum for the 4 core areas K-12. Phase 2 will take place next year as we begin to improve on our assessment process. Also, for the 2020/2021 year, we will focus on improving and creating more consistent practices for our RTI/MTSS model. We also will continue to refine our PBIS model and create more supportive interventions for the social and emotional needs of our students.

For Social Studies, we use the Grade Level Content Expectations for 6<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> grades.
