# **OPEN HOUSE FORMS**

Parents, PLEASE turn in <u>ALL</u> the forms that were sent home with you in your Open House folders if you have not done so already!! There are many of you who have not.

#### STUDENT ABSENCES/TARDIES

You <u>must</u> call the school prior to 8:30 a.m. (**734-848-5475**, **follow prompts**) when your child is going to be absent. We have an answering machine for those early morning calls. Also, if your child arrives late, <u>an adult MUST walk</u> them into the office. Children are not to be dropped off late without an adult signing them in. School begins at **8:10 a.m.** and all students <u>must</u> be in their classroom by that time. If your child arrives between **8:10 a.m.** and **8:50 a.m.** they are considered **tardy**, if your child **arrives after 8:50 they will be marked as ½ day A.M. absence.** These procedures are mandated by the state of Michigan. If you need to sign your child out early, please make sure to send a note. For more detailed information regarding our attendance policy, please visit our website.

# **SIGN OUTS**

Please do not sign your child out right before dismissal unless necessary. It will be marked as a partial absence on their attendance. The office and driveway need to be clear for a safe and smooth dismissal for our students.
