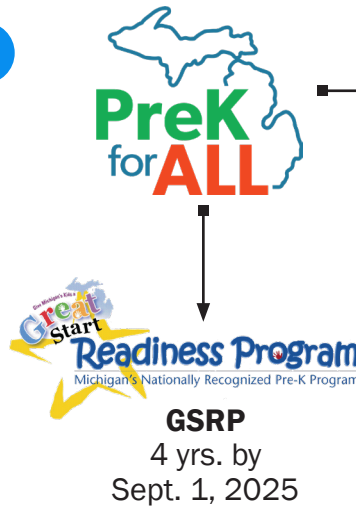

## APPLICATION CHECKLIST

We will have MCISD staff available to complete your child's application.

**TO COMPLETE YOUR CHILD'S APPLICATION, YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING:**

- ✓ Proof of Income (only 1 needed)
  - 2024 W-2s
  - Income Tax Return
  - SSI, TANF, SNAP
  - 4 weeks of pay stubs
- ✓ Foster Care documentation (if applicable)
- ✓ Child's Birth Certificate
- ✓ Immunization Record (if available)
- ✓ Proof of Residency (only 1 needed) (drivers license, bill, rent lease, etc.)

*\*SB 133 allows children turning 4 between Sept. 2, 2025 - Dec. 1, 2025 to submit a waiver application. Space is limited based on availability and location. Enrollment may be considered after August 1, 2025.*
