

Operations Administrative Report

- **Home Press Box Improvements:** The upper level has been reconfigured to accommodate both teams, with two separate rooms created to provide designated areas for team use and improve organization during games.
- **Entryway Improvements:** Painted the heater covers located in the High school entryways to improve their appearance and maintain a clean, well-kept appearance throughout the district.
- **Building Entrance Lettering:** Repainted the lettering at all building entrances to improve visibility and provide a fresh, professional appearance at each facility.
- **Middle School CTE/Shop Room:** Significant progress was made on the new middle school shop room (located in the High School). The ventilation system and dust collection system have been installed, and electrical work is nearing completion.
- **High School Exterior Doors:** Applied fresh paint to the exterior doors at the high school to improve the appearance of the building and help protect the doors from weather-related wear.
- **Classroom Improvements:** Installed new whiteboards in several classrooms to provide teachers and students with updated instructional surfaces and improve classroom functionality.
- **Soffit Repairs:** Replaced several deteriorated soffit boards where rotting had occurred. These areas were also allowing birds to enter the building, so the repairs will help prevent further animal intrusion and protect the building from additional damage.
- **Pest Removal:** The Frames team responded to a yellow jacket nest that was discovered inside a classroom. The nest was safely removed to address the immediate safety concern and ensure the classroom remained safe for students and staff.
