Public Comment Follow-up

A question was presented regarding the employment of an individual staff member. The District follows all applicable provisions of the Michigan Revised School Code, including Section 1236.

Comment about additional team-taught classes: The District's assignment of staff is based on student needs, available staffing, and employee certification and qualifications. Team-teaching and co-teaching and collaborative instructional models have been utilized in a variety of ways across the district for many years. At the high school, for example, Focus classes have at times included as many as three staff members working together to meet student needs. During the past school year, both Ms. Radant and Ms. Malik taught a Focus team-taught period. In the past, the HS ran a freshman academy where two teachers would have one class as well. These staffing decisions are made to provide appropriate instructional support while making the best use of available personnel and resources.

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The District will continue to evaluate staffing and instructional programming each year to ensure we are meeting the educational needs of our students while remaining in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

Accepted the resignation of Lori Manley, CES teacher. Lori was a dedicated educator who had a passion for teaching and learning and impacted many generations of Eagle kiddos here.
