Spring Sports:

Boys Track and Field

This year was another successful Boy Track and Field season. We were undefeated in all dual meets, going 6-0 and won the League Meet by nearly 90 points to become 2025 TCC champions.

We placed second as a team at the regional meet where we qualified for 7 events for the **2025 MHSAA State Finals**.

Girls Track and Field

This year was a great season for our girls' track and field team by going undefeated in the TCC conference and winning the **2025 TCC League Championship** 3 years in a row. We also had nine ladies qualified for the **2025 MHSAA State Meet** and became the 1st girls track and field team in school history to win a **MHSAA Regional Championship (2025) and finish MHSAA "Runner Up" Division 3**
