Filter First Program

Monroe Plumbing continues to make significant progress on completing the district's Filter First installations. Remaining items include the installation of in-line filters in the high school and elementary kitchens, as well as work on the gym drinking fountains at both the middle school and high school. Facilities staff will complete the final steps of the project, including installing signage and uploading photos to the required spreadsheet, during Christmas break.

Osprey Deterrent and Pole Removal

The district partnered with Cress Tree Service to remove an old light pole where an osprey had repeatedly built a nest. During the installation of deterrents, it was discovered that the wooden frame supporting the lighting was deteriorating and posed a potential safety risk to visitors seated nearby. Due to these safety concerns, the decision was made to remove the entire pole.

Roofing Improvements

Facilities staff are continuing to monitor and improve roofing conditions across the district. During a recent inspection, several areas of concern were identified and are currently under review. Additionally, the district has partnered with Lutz Roofing to address active leaks located in the high school kitchen and at Elementary Door 4.

Secure Vestibule Upgrades

Tanner Supply has completed the installation of new secure vestibule doors at both the high school and elementary school. The middle school vestibule project is planned for completion during summer break, as it requires more extensive work, including the construction of a new wall to ensure a fully secure entryway.

GSRP Mini Split System

American Heating and Cooling installed a new mini-split system in the GSRP classroom to ensure the space maintains a consistent temperature.
