- Since going fully remote, our attendance numbers have held steady. We are in the range of 93%, this is very similar to our numbers when in person.
- Due to COVID restrictions, the PBIS Eagle Power program at the middle school has not been able to hold fundraisers. Thanks to the generosity of the parent group and a local business, the program will continue to recognize students. Roy's Dixie Delight donated 15 - \$10 gift certificates and the PTSA donated \$1000 to the Eagle Power program. Gift cards will be purchased with some of the donated funds and will be used along with the Roy's Dixie Delight gift certificates to recognize students in the weekly Eagle Power card drawings.
- Our PBIS committee is putting together holiday packages full of goodies for a select group of students who have been meeting all the attendance and academic requirements since going fully remote. These students will be entered into a drawing where 10 students at each grade level will be selected. We have several teachers who will be delivering these packages to the students who were randomly chosen.
- Our teachers will be meeting with Sara Shriver this Friday for our district provided professional development. Sara will be providing direction and feedback to our teachers on their curriculum work. We are close to finishing phase 1 of this process which includes our "I can" statements, pacing guides, and instructional resources.
