AGE REQUIREMENTS

EHS serves prenatal women and families with children from birth through 3 years of age. At 3 years old, we work to transition your child into a Head Start classroom.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

To complete your child's application, you will need the following:

- Proof of Income (any of the following)
 - W-2s
 - Income Tax Return
 - SSI, TANF, SNAP
 - 4 weeks of pay stubs
- Foster Care documentation if applicable
- Child's Birth Certificate (if available)
- Immunization Record (if available)
- Proof of Residency (drivers license, bill, lease, etc.)
