New Coaches

Girls Basketball

The Lady Eagles have continued to battle injuries all season long. The younger players have improved and stepped up when needed. The team had a nice victory over Whiteford 42-41 on January 20th. Senior Kaylie Bash led the Eagles scoring 25 points and made clutch free throws at the end of the game to clinch the victory. The season continues through February and districts will be held at Blissfield high school during the first week of March.

Boys Basketball

Wrestling

The wrestling team took 2nd place at the Tri County Conference team tournament. We will be hosting TCC individual meet on February 1st followed by the team district on February 8th.

We also have four girls competing on the team and their individual regionals will be held on February 19th. Ann Mare and Elliot Gessner are both looking to make a repeat trip to the state final tournament.

Boys Swim

The boys swim team has a current winning record. They have one their last two meets with wins over Detroit Country Day and Monroe high school. The SMISL championship will be held on March 4th at Dundee High School.
