- ☐ Proof of Income
  - 2021 W-2s
  - Income Tax Return
  - SSI, TANF
  - 4 weeks of pay stubs
- Foster Care documentation if applicable
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Immunization Record (if available)
- Proof of Residency (drivers license, bill, rent lease, etc.)

\*SB 133 allows children turning 4 between Sept. 2, 2022 – Dec. 1, 2022 to submit a waiver application. Space is limited based on availability and location. Enrollment may be considered after Sept. 1, 2022.
