- The virtual parent teacher conferences went very well. We are holding at approximately 95% participation with a few additional conferences scheduled for this week!
- The IRIPS – individual reading improvement plans – were discussed with the parents at the parent teacher conferences. This is the current fall IRIP counts for each grade: Y5s – 3, Kindergarten – 14, Grade 1 – 24, Grade 2 – 26, Grade 3 – 26 and Grade 4 – 6. That is approximately 28.13% of our students in Grades Y5-4<sup>th</sup> with an IRIP.
- The pre-k programs will hold their parent-teacher conferences on Nov. 13 and 20<sup>th</sup>!
- The PTA will sponsored a blood drive sponsored by the American Red Cross on Nov. 11<sup>th</sup> from 2 pm – 7 pm at Central. ALL Covid-19 safety protocols and practices will be followed during the blood drive.
- We are all extremely proud of our students and staff on how they are doing a phenomenal job following the safety protocols for the first half of trimester #1. The students are respectful and mindful of wearing the masks, washing hands, social distancing and overall – just happy to back to school!
- I have been keeping the unit leaders very busy with meetings. We discussed the possible shutdown plans to be best prepared if that in fact would happen. Other items addressed at the October 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting: evaluations and observations, curriculum work, safe schools training, MTSS data meetings and parent teacher conferences.
