Football:

The varsity football team finished with a winning record of 5-4 which was good enough for a third-place finish in the Tri-County Conference. They earned the last available playoff position in division 6 based on the new MHSAA playoff point system. They will face Ida on 10/29/21 in the first round of the districts.

Volleyball:

The volleyball team ended their regular season with a victory over the Morenci Bulldogs on 10/26. The lady eagles were runner ups in the Tri-County Conference with a record of 9-3.

Volleyball begins the MHSAA district playoff at Adrian-Madison on Monday 11/1 versus Blissfield. If they lady eagles win, they will move to play the host team Adrian-Madison on Wednesday 11/3.

Cross Country:

The boys' cross country won their second consecutive Tri-County Conference championship. The Eagles had 3 out of the top 4 finishers at the championship meet. Jackson Ansel 1st overall, Jacoba Ansel 3rd and Ethan Cuschieri 4th.

The girls' cross country team finished 4th place in the league. Bailey Meiring earned 1st team all-league honors by placing 3rd at the league meet.

Cross Country regionals will be held on 10/30 at Hudson Mills Metropark. The teams and individuals can qualify for the state meet on 11/6 held Michigan International Speedway.
