- Teachers are preparing for parent-teacher conferences set for October 21st and 22nd. Conferences will be held through phone conferences and or Google Meet. Teachers will be reviewing the first trimester interim reports and the IRIP (Individual Reading Improvement Plans) for students in grades kindergarten through fourth grade. Our goal is to have 100% attendance at the parent teacher conferences.
- We have completed the requirement set by MDE to test all students within the first six weeks of school. Teachers will also review the results with the parents at conferences next week.
- We currently have 106 on full remote learning option and 301 attending school face to face. Students have been working very hard and are adjusting well to the new learning environment.
- Teachers worked with Lynn Fleck, ISD Literacy Coach, this past week reviewing the ELA data for the IRIPs. The MTSS program model has been modified to reflect the phase four return to school plan. We continue to adjust the interventions based on the resources available.
- All staff will be trained in the ALICE program on October 30, 2020 for the PD planned for that afternoon.
- Our GSRP program is almost full with 15 enrolled. We have one slot available. We are hoping the enrollment will soon increase for our half day morning tuition based program.
