Mason Consolidated Schools Pay to Participate Athletic Fee 2022-2023

All students participating in athletics for the school year 2021-2022, must pay a One-time activity fee. The Activity Fee is designed to offset the cost of operating our athletic program. Officials, transportation, custodial services, field and court maintenance, supplies, and coaching salaries affect the total cost of the Athletic Program.

Onetime fee:

High School Sports \$100.00/year Middle School Sports: \$75/year -Family Max \$200 at any combined level per year

Deadline: The fee may be paid in the high school office to Katelyn Hodge at any time between 8:00 AM and 2:00 PM (This includes the summer). All fees are to be turned in to the office and not a coach. A receipt must be written upon turning the fee in. Also, the fee must be turned in PRIOR TO the first official contest before the student is allowed to participate.

Method of Payment:

- Checks, money orders, cash will be accepted.
- Write Full Name, Street Address and phone number, including area code on check
- Write student name and sport on check
- Make checks payable to Mason Consolidated Schools

Mason Consolidated Schools has contracted with eCashflow Services for the electronic collection of checks returned for insufficient funds (NSF). The school district will continue to accept your checks. When you provide a check as payment you authorize us to collect the face amount of your check plus applicable fees through an electronic fund transfer from your account if your payment is returned unpaid. All checks that are currently past due will also be recovered through this process. Please include the following on your check: Full Name, Street Address and Phone Numbers. Refunds: Pay to participate athletic fees will not be refunded for any reason including but not limited to injuries, suspension, discipline, eligibility, athlete quitting the team, or athletic handbook or student code of conduct violations after the first game.

Hardships: If anyone finds this fee to be a hardship, he/she may contact the Athletic office where an application form may be completed to sell tickets at events in lieu of the athletic fee.
