Memorial Scholarship Fund

The Robert W. Wohlgamuth scholarship has been founded in memory of Robert W. Wohlgamuth. His family has taken this opportunity to help local scholar athletes in the Monroe County, MI area that have exhibited a strong work ethic in education and athletics. This Athletic/Scholastic scholarship will be awarded to a minimum of one male and one female Monroe County, MI high school student. Each student will be selected by the Robert W. Wohlgamuth Scholarship Committee.

Students interested in participating must complete the application and return it with transcripts of grades, essay, official ACT or SAT scores (if applicable), and letters of recommendation by one coach and one teacher. Each student's name will be removed from their information and given a number prior to the committee receiving their information. The committee will only receive the names of the selected person(s) after the selection process is final. All information received will be considered as confidential and will not be shared with anyone except the Robert W. Wohlgamuth Scholarship committee.

Eligibility:

- ◆ Student must reside in Monroe County, MI for at least 1 yr.
- ◆ Student must have and maintain a GPA of 3.0 in a Monroe County, MI School.
- ◆ Student must be a high school senior who has participated in a high school sport for a minimum of 2 years and is currently participating on one or more athletic team(s).
PLEASE NOTE: If you were only able to participate in 1 year of sports due to COVID-19 please submit your application and essay anyway and make note of that.
- ◆ Student must have clean disciplinary records, both school and athletic record.
- ◆ Student must successfully complete graduation requirements in the current school year.

Essay:

Complete an approximate 750 word essay (typed in 12 point Calibri or Times New Roman font) that captures the following items:

- ◆ How has the participation in athletics affected your life and prepared you for your future goals?

- ♦ How has your academic studies benefited you and where do you see yourself in your future professional career?
- ♦ Why should you be selected for the Robert W. Wohlgamuth Scholarship?

Award Process:

This one time award amount of \$2,500 is non-renewable. The number of scholarships awarded will depend on our annual golf outing fundraiser. There will be no less than one male and one female recipient. Formal notification of scholarship award will be made via letter from the Robert W. Wohlgamuth Scholarship Committee to the selected person(s).

Payment of scholarship:

The Robert W. Wohlgamuth Scholarship will be paid directly to the accredited college or vocational program the student is enrolled in. Verification of enrollment must be provided prior to check being presented to recipient.

All required information must be postmarked by March 27, 2021.
