- The parent/guardian clicks the link in the email to sign the release forms, completes the application with their signatures and clicks "submit." Parent/guardian forms must also be completed by the 11:59 P.M. on October 26, 2020.
- 6 Completed applications will be reviewed and students will be notified by November 23, 2020 of their admission to the program.
