Projects account for 80% of student's grade

Sketchbooks:

A "First Fifteen" sketchbook assignment will be given every day during the first fifteen minutes of class. Students will be expected to work on assignment independently. Sketchbooks will be graded at the end of every week and a single grade for the entire week will be given. Any missed sketchbooks must be made up. Sketchbooks account for 20% of student's grade.

Mid Term exam will be a written exam covering information from first semester

Final Exam will be a combination of artwork and presentation.

Classroom Procedures:

- Entering class- students begin working on sketchbook upon entering class.
- Materials- students are expected to have a #2 pencil with them every day.
- All students should be facing teacher and quiet while teacher is speaking.
- Students present in class are expected to work in class.
