These are the requirements for Mason High School's yearbook photos:

- You must deliver one full-color indoor studio photo to Mr. Bowers by **November 22, 2023**.
- Please email to bowers@eriemason.k12.mi.us – Subject: **Senior Picture**, or deliver on disc/flash drive.
- Your photo must be a high resolution (300 DPI or higher) **JPEG** format with a minimum ratio of 2.5" x 3.5"
- Please use **Old Master or similar studio background (*NO WHITE BACKGROUNDS*)** with high backlight, but no backlit hair.
- Portraits should be vertical head and shoulder shots. No horizontal or full body shots.
- No props, hats, or hands by the face in photos. No borders, special effects, or text

PLEASE FOLLOW SCHOOL DRESS CODE AND ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING:

- No Hats, bandanas, etc.
- **Girls:** No spaghetti straps, sleeveless shirts, or plunging necklines.
- **Boys:** At a minimum wear a collared polo/golf shirt but a long sleeved dress shirt is preferred. A jacket is suggested as well.
- In general: Solid colors are the best; shirts should not have writing on them. White tends to have a widening effect and black can be more slimming.
