### STUDENT TARDIES

School begins at **8:10 a.m.** and all students **must** be in their classroom by that time. Teachers mark attendance first thing in the morning. If your child arrives between **8:10 a.m. and 8:50 a.m.** they are considered **tardy**, if your child **arrives after 8:50 a.m. they will be marked as ½ day a.m. absence**. A written note is needed for sign in/sign outs as well. These procedures are mandated by the State of Michigan, and we must follow them. Doors will be closed and locked at 8:10 a.m. for the safety of all students and staff. A parent **MUST** come into the building and sign their student(s) in at the office if they arrive at 8:10 a.m. or later.

### NO SCHOOL

### ILLNESS

The best way to prevent illnesses in our school is for children to stay home when they are sick. **Your child must be vomit, diarrhea, and fever free for 24 hours** (without the use of fever reducing medicine) before returning to school. This is per the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services.
