- Parent Teacher Conferences will be held Thursday October 24, 2024, from 11:30 to 2:30 and 3:00 to 6.
- Mrs. Costello, Mrs. Hennessey, and Mr. Travis have been collecting resources to support our McKenny Vento programs. They have been providing financial support by purchasing school supplies, gas cards, clothes, personal care items, and covering school activity needs for those students that qualify. The resources used to fund these purchases were provided through the ARP Homeless Grant.
- Manufacturing Day takes place on Thursday, October 3, 2024. This year we will be taking 22 students to MTS Seating where we will get an inside look at how this business operates. We will specifically meet with human resources and engineers to learn more about their business and how they contribute to the world around us. Later, we will go through the stages of building a chair where students will get some hands-on experiences with 3-D printers, constructing chairs and putting the finishing touches on a chair. We are very excited for this experience as it will bridge the gap between the math we are learning in the classroom and how it can connect with the real world.
