Real college admission and scholarship offers — with **no application to submit** .
Here's how it works, and exactly what to do when your offers arrive.

READ THIS FIRST

An offer is a real offer of admission. Do not re-apply, just accept or decline.

If a participating college sends you an offer, **you have already been admitted**. Your only next step is to **accept the offers you want to move forward with**. There is nothing more to submit after you've responded.

How it works

1

Build your profile

Create your Match profile in under 15 minutes.

2

Transcripts uploaded

You or your school adds a transcript to your profile.

3

Offers arrive

Colleges send real admission & potential scholarship offers.

4

Click interested

Accept the offers you want to move forward with. This is **REQUIRED**.

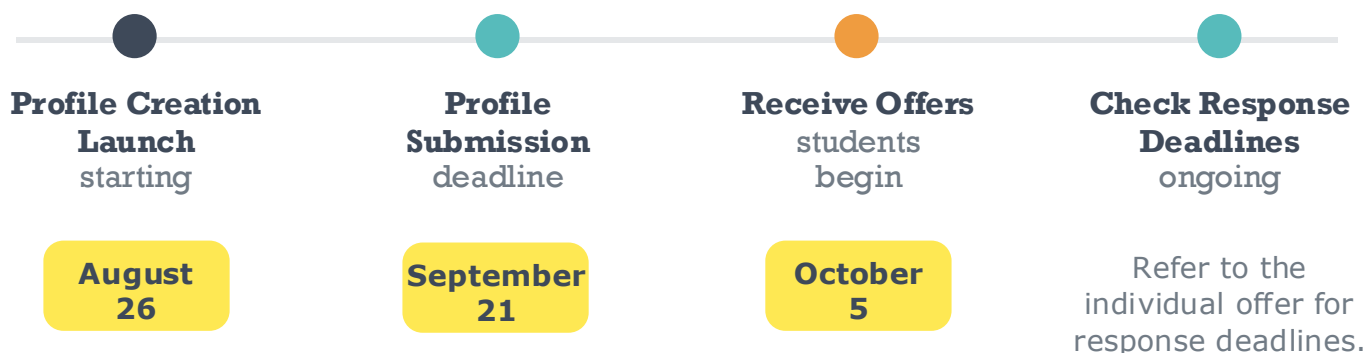

You got an offer — now what?

Two things to remember, so your offers turn into real, confirmed spots.



DO accept your offers

Accepting is the **only way a college receives your information**. Until you accept, the college does not know who you are and does not have your record or transcript.



DON'T apply directly

The offer **is** your admission — there is no separate application to submit. Applying again to that college is unnecessary and can create a **duplicate application and admission review**.

Didn't get an offer from a college you hoped for?

If a participating college didn't send you an offer, it's because **you may have indicated you had already applied there**. If that's not the case and you'd like to be considered for regular admission, apply directly through that college's own traditional application.

After you click interested and release your information to the college:

- 1 Watch for direct contact in your email.** Expect the institution to reach out to you directly within **3-4 business days**. Please give them a little time — we're transferring your record and transcripts over to them.
- 2 Read your "Conditions of Admission" in the offer.** This section of your offer usually lists exactly what's needed to be fully admitted at the institution.
- 3 Follow each individual college's next steps.** Every institution has its own next steps and will communicate them to you directly.



About your scholarships

Most participating colleges include scholarship details with the offer — shown as either a **range** or an **exact amount**. To unlock your full award and see everything you qualify for, you may need to submit documentation and your **FAFSA** directly to the institution.

Quick answers

Are these offers real?

Yes — genuine admission offers, with no further application needed.

Can I accept more than one?

Yes — accept as many offers as interest you.

Do I have to attend?

No. Accepting an offer is not a commitment to enroll.

Do offers expire?

Yes. Respond as soon as you can so you don't miss out.
