Football:

This year of not being in a conference was tough football season. Our football team suffered a ton of injuries, and we finished the season 1-8 overall. Next year we made the decision to join with the 2 remaining TCC 11-Man football teams (Whiteford and Summerfield) the TAAC football conference in Ohio. This will ensure stability in a football conference and allow our student athletes the opportunity to continue to compete at a high-level year in and year out.

MS Football:

MS football competed in every game this year finishing 1-5 overall in the LCAA MS conference. They will join us and compete in the MS TAAC football conference as well next year.

Volleyball:
