The 17 Goals were adopted by all UN Member States in 2015, as part of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development which set out a 15-year plan to achieve the Goals. Today, progress is being made in many places, but, overall, action to meet the Goals is not yet advancing at the speed or scale required. 2020 needs to usher in a decade of ambitious action to deliver the Goals by 2030.

### How can we address this?

'No one left behind' is at the core of the sustainable development agenda for 2030 and if economic growth is to build a fairer world, it must be inclusive. This is the idea behind Goal 8, which aims to sustain an economic growth rate of 7% for the least developed countries by 2030, and achieve full and productive employment for all men and women everywhere in the next 15 years. In 2015, nearly 736 million people live on can we address this?

### About SDG -8

SDG 8 - Promote inclusive and sustainable economic growth, employment and decent work for all

What exactly is this goal?: during the last 25 years the number of workers living in extreme poverty has fallen considerably. However, more than 780 million people earn no more than \$2 a day. On the other hand, according to the International Labor Organization (ILO), there are more than 204 million unemployed people today. The lack of work and the poor quality of it indirectly impacts on the rise of poverty and inequalities at global level. SDG 8 aims to achieve sustainable and inclusive economic growth, which can benefit all and that is not detrimental to the environment. This will only be achieved by creating decent jobs for everyone, especially for women, young people and other disadvantaged groups, eliminating practices such as forced and child labour and promoting technological innovation.

Corporate role: companies are the main tool for creating jobs, and they must ensure decent working conditions, for both their own employees as well as those employed throughout the supply chain.

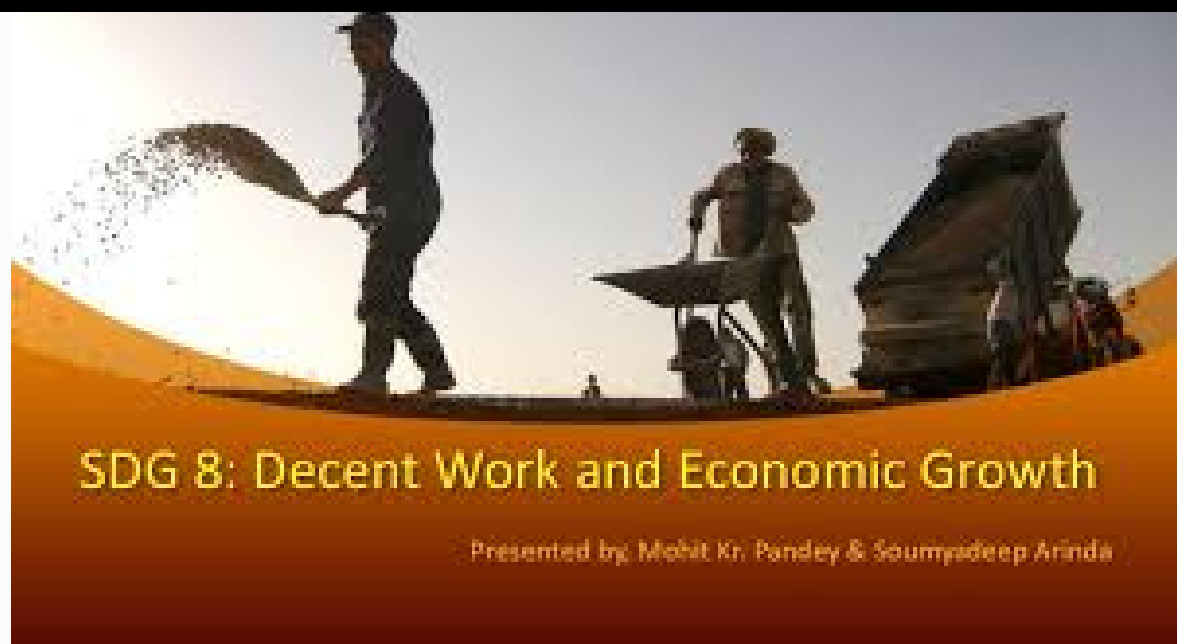
