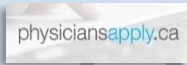

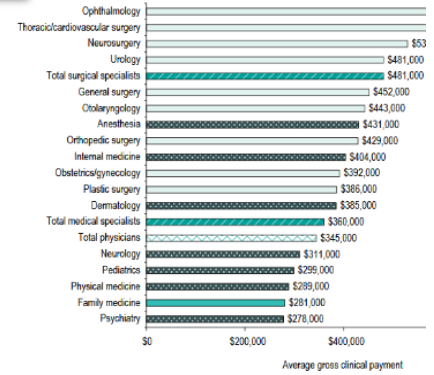

Terminology

CMG = Canadian Medical Graduate (Canadian who studied and graduated from a Canadian Medical School)

IMG = International Medical Graduate (There are 2 types of IMG:

1. CSA: A Canadian who studied and graduated from an International Medical School or a "Canadian who Studied Abroad" (CSA)
2. FMG: An immigrant to/PR of Canada who studied and graduated from an International Medical School or a "Foreign Medical Graduate" (FMG)
