#### **Historic Bill Wood Field**

Bill Wood Field was built in 1955 as after Union Pacific Park burned down

- Old park was home to the North Platte Buffaloes, who played from 1928-1932 in D Ball and were manged by Spud Ownes
- Has been the home to multiple minor league and unaffiliated teams
- North Platte Indians played at Bill Wood from 1956-1959, Short-Season D Ball
- Saw renovations in the 1980s and in 2021 to get it ready for the Plainsmen, including improved dugouts and new signs in the outfield

#### Whats in a Name

Plainsmen name stretches back decades, first being used in the 1960s by a Legion Team

- That team played in the Basin League, played in a championship game
- Modern name remained dormant until 2022 when it was given to the new colligeate team

## HEAD COACH JARED JONES



Jared Jones is entering his first season as the Head Coach of the North Platte Plainsmen. Jones is a graduate of Central Christian College, where he played baseball and earned a Bachelors in Physical Education. At Central Christian, Jones hit .271 with 1 Home Run and 17 RBI over three seasons.

Jones grad transfered to Dakota Weslyan University where he played baseball at the NAIA level and earned his Master is Educational Policy while hitting .191/.250/.397 with 3 Home Runs and 15 RBI.

After finishing his playing career, Jones joined the staff at Highland Community College in Highland, Kansas as player development coordinator.

In July of 2022, Jones was promoted to the title of Hitting Coach and Director of Player Development. On game days, Jones is the first base coach for the Scotties along with coaching the hitters and outfielders and overseeing the strength and conditioning program.

Jones will be entering his third season of coaching Collegiate summer baseball. Jones spent 2021 and 2022 coaching in the Cornbelt Summer Collegiate League, serving as the head coach for the Omaha Cropdusters. The league itself was based in Omaha, Nebraska with all teams competing in the city.

Jones is from Edmond, Oklahoma, and currently lives in Highland, Kansas.

### **ASSISTANT COACH DAVIN CONWAY**



Davin Conway joins the Plainsmen after graduating from Knox College with a degree in Political Science. Conway then grad transferred to Cabrini where he earned a masters Political Science with a focus in Educational Policy.

Over 28 innings at Knox, Conway finished with a 8.58 ERA and 25 strikeouts along with an ERA of 11.37 in 2 years and 6 innings at Cabrini.

Conway is from Sarcoxie, Missouri and is entering his first coaching job at the college level.
