General Shoot Information

The 2020 Florida Skeet Championship is a registered tournament and will be held under all current NSSA and FSA rules. Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or postpone any part of the program or refuse any entry. Shooters may be squadded outside of assigned shoot rotations when necessary.

There is no deposit required, but if you register and have to cancel, please notify FSA at the email address or telephone number listed below. Participants can register for this event at www.floridaskeet.com under the "Registration" page.

All events will be shot 100 targets on a field using the flight system. Each flight will have one and a half hours to shoot 100 targets. Each flight will start on time, and in case of breakdown, slow squad, etc., shoot management reserves the right to move the squad to a practice field. Any squad or shooter not ready when called will be placed in the last squad or flight of the day, if space is available. If space is not available, the squad or shooters will not be able to shoot that event.

Shooters will provide their own proof shells.

All score sheets must be initialed by a squad member before leaving the field after each round.

Shoot-Off Information

Ties for Gun CH, RU, 3rd & Class 1st will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by long-run. Ties for Concurrent CH, RU, 3rd & Class 1st will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by long-run

The .410 shoot-offs will be all regulation miss and out. 28, 20, and 12 gauge shoot-offs will be doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5 by station, NSSA rules.

Ties for HOA CH, RU, 3rd & Class 1st will be shot off. Ties for Concurrent CH, RU, 3rd & Class 1st will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by 12 ga long run from the front and .410 from the back Winners of Open Championship Award will not be eligible for Class Awards.

Shoot-offs will be held as soon as possible after completion of the event. It will be each shooter's sole responsibility to determine the shoot-off procedure in which he or she may be involved on any particular day. The shooter forfeits all rights if absent at the time the shoot-off is called. In the event of impending darkness, ominous weather conditions, breakdowns or other reasons which would make the conduct of regulation shoot-offs inadvisable, the shoot management reserves the right to substitute any procedure that it may deem desirable, and notice of such change will be given as soon as possible.


