- 2. Shooters wishing to shoot together must preregister together.
- 3. On-site registration hours are as follows: Friday, March 27, 10:30 AM 5:30 PM. All other days, 8:00 AM.
- 4. Preference will be given to 4-gun shooters. Shooters participating in fewer than the entire 4-gun Program will be scheduled as near to requested times as possible, but must be accommodated at the convenience of shoot management by necessity.
- Shooters must present their classification/shoot record with all scores shot prior to the current date properly and legibly recorded.

IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SHOOTER TO VERIFY ALL ENTRY INFORMATION BEFORE LEAVING THE REGISTRATION AREA.

6. There will be no refunds for withdrawals, except in the case of extreme emergencies. There will be no refunds for withdrawal due to adverse weather conditions.

Shooting Procedures

- 1. Current NSSA rules will be used throughout the tournament, unless otherwise stated in the program or posted in the registration area.
- 2. All events will be shot 100 targets on a field using the flight system. Each flight will have one and a half hours to shoot 100 targets. Each flight will start on time, and in the case of breakdowns, slow squad, etc.., shoot management reserves the right to move the squad to an available field. Any squad or shooter not ready when called will be placed on a space available basis. If space is not available, the squad or shooters will not be able to shoot the event. No refunds will be issued in these cases.
- 3. All changes to a squad line up must be made at registration prior to shooting the event. No changes will be made on the field without the permission of shoot management.
- 4. Shooters will provide their own proof shells.

Shoot-offs & Ties

Shoot-offs will be held as soon as possible after the completion of the last event of the day. It is the responsibility of the shooter to determine the shoot-off in which he or she may be involved on any particular day. The shooter forfeits all rights if absent at the time the shoot-off is called. In the event of impending darkness, ominous weather conditions, breakdowns, or other reasons which would make the conduct of regulation shoot-offs unadvisable, the shoot management reserves the right to substitute any procedure that it may deem desirable, and notice of such changes will be given as soon as possible.

Shoot-off Order (Barring Weather Delays)

Friday Night: Doubles

Saturday Night: 12 Gauge, 20 Gauge

Sunday Night: 28 Gauge, .410 Bore, HOA

Shoot-off Procedures

All shoot-offs will be Doubles, Stations 3, 4 and 5 – Miss and out by station using NSSA rules for procedures for shoot-offs.

- 1. Ties for Gun CH, RU, 3rd, and Class 1, 2, 3 in all Guns, Doubles, and HOA will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by long run.
- 2. Concurrent ties for CH, RU, and 3rd will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by long run.
- 3. Long runs in all guns and Doubles will be decided from the front or back scoring of that gun. Long runs for HOA will be decided using the scoring from the front of the 12 gauge and the back of the .410 bore.

Other Information:

- 1. Shoot management reserves the right to change, cancel, or postpone any part of the program.
- 2. Shoot management reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any participant who annoys, endangers, or interferes with the harmony of the shoot.
- Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on host gun club properties.
