### GENERAL INFORMATION

**The NSSA has contributed a \$1,000 grant to our Zone Shoot. The grant will be awarded to HOA Class 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners, prorated by the number of 4-gun entries in each class. There is no entry fee for this event.**

#### Fees

**GUN FEES:** \$55 per gun (includes all fees)

**HOA AND CLASS HOA:** No charge

**CONCURRENTS:** No charge

#### Awards

**Class medals:** 1st–5th in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA; **Concurrent CH, RU, and 3rd; Ladies Group 1 & 2, 1st & 2nd.**  
**Gun medallions:** CH, RU, and 3rd in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, & .410.  
**Belt buckles:** HOA CH, RU, 3rd, and Class 1st (AAA–D).

#### Champ Of Champs

NO CHARGE

**Winner receives a silver belt buckle.**

All Zone 4 entrants are eligible.

Winner determined by last 25 of each gauge.

#### SCTP Concurrent

NO CHARGE

**Awards to CH, RU, and 3rd.**

12 gauge only, active members of SCTP are eligible to enter

#### Optional Purse Events

**Optional Class Purse:** \$10.00 per event; offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA; payouts: 1–5 shooters, 100% to winner; 6–10, 60/40; 11+, 50/30/20.

**Oklahoma Options (50s):** \$15.00 per event; offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA; by class, ties divide.

**Handicap Option:** \$10.00 per event; offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA; maximum score wins, ties divide.

**12 GA BCDE Options:** \$10.00 per event; 12-gauge only for B, C, D, and E classes; shooters posting a perfect 25 in any round split the pot.

**Lewis Class Option:** \$10.00 per event; offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA; 1 class for every 10 entries, ties split.

#### Eligibility and Classification

1. This is a closed event. Shooters must be current NSSA members and Zone 4 residents, as verified by NSSA records and Rule III-A-4-a.
2. For all events entered, shooters must provide their current NSSA classification information.
3. AAA class eligibility will be based on the average from the shooter's most recent classification or reclassification in the applicable gauge.
4. Teams are not required to shoot shoulder-to-shoulder but must shoot at the same host site.
5. A shooter's HOA class will not be lower than their lowest gun class.

**IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SHOOTER TO VERIFY ALL ENTRY INFORMATION BEFORE LEAVING THE REGISTRATION AREA.**

ANY SHOOTER WHOSE CLASSIFICATION OR EVENT ENTRY IS INCORRECT AND NOT CORRECTED BEFORE SHOOTING WILL FORFEIT ALL MEDALS AND OPTION MONIES FOR THAT EVENT. THE CLASS WILL BE CORRECTED, BUT NO FURTHER ACTION WILL BE TAKEN.

#### Registration

1. Pre-register online at [iskeet.org/isreg](http://iskeet.org/isreg).
2. On-site registration hours: Friday, August 7, 11 AM – 6 PM; all other days begin at 8 AM.
3. Shooters entering fewer than the full 4-gun program will be scheduled as close to their requested times as possible, subject to shoot management needs.
4. To enter any HOA event, shooters must register and pay for all associated events before starting the first gauge.
5. Refunds will not be issued for withdrawals, cancellations due to weather, or ineligible entries discovered after the event has been shot, except in extreme emergencies.

Only Zone shoot management may make changes to the rotation schedule. Specific club procedures will be posted at club registration.

#### Shooting Procedures

1. Unless otherwise noted in the program or at registration, current NSSA rules govern the tournament.
2. All events are 100 targets per field using the flight system. Each flight has 1.5 hours to complete 100 targets and will begin on time. In the event of a breakdown, slow squad, or similar issue, shoot management may move a squad to another field.
3. Each host site must complete shooting by 6:00 PM local time, subject to weather or other unforeseen delays such as trap breakdowns.
4. Any squad or shooter not ready when called will be placed on a space-available basis. If no space is available, they cannot shoot the event, and no refunds will be issued.
5. Squad lineup changes must be made at registration before the event. Changes made on the field without shoot management's permission will disqualify those participants from that event.
6. Shooters must provide their own proof shells.

### Shoot-offs and Ties

Shoot-offs begin promptly after the day's final event. Shooters are responsible for knowing their daily shoot-offs. Anyone absent when called forfeits participation. Shoot management may adjust procedures for darkness, weather, or other conditions and will announce any changes promptly.

**TO MINIMIZE DELAYS, PLEASE BRING TWO BOXES OF AMMUNITION TO ALL SHOOT-OFFS.**

### Shoot-off Procedures

1. Shoot-offs across all locations will be determined using iSkeet software.
2. For all events, shoot-offs will be conducted on Doubles Stations 3, 4, & 5
3. Shooters will continue until two misses or until two boxes have been completed.

### Shoot-off Order (Weather Permitting)

**Friday night:** Doubles  
**Saturday night:** 12 Gauge and 20 Gauge  
**Sunday night:** 28 Gauge, .410 Bore, and HOA

1. Ties for Gun CH, RU, 3rd, & Class 1, 2, & 3 in all guns, Doubles, & HOA will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by long run.
2. Concurrent ties for CH, RU, 3rd, & Class 1 CH will be shot off. All other concurrent ties will be decided by long run.
3. Long runs in all guns & Doubles will be decided from the front or back score of that gun. HOA long runs will be decided using the front score of the 12 Gauge and the back score of the .410 Bore.

### Other Information:

1. All payouts will be mailed.
2. Shoot management reserves the right to change, cancel, or postpone any part of the program.
3. Shoot management may refuse entry or remove any participant for annoying others, endangering others, disrupting the shoot, or unsportsmanlike conduct including score or classification falsification, cheating, abuse, etc.
4. Protests must be filed with the Protest Committee within 30 minutes of the flight's end. The committee members will be posted during the shoot. Its ruling is final.
5. Spectators and contestants assume all risk for accidents or property loss on host gun club property.
