12 ga Shoot off immediately follows

10:45 AM ROTATION - Fields, 1, 2 & 3

20 Gauge - 50 targets
20 ga Shoot off immediately follows

LUNCH BREAK

1:00 PM ROTATION - Fields 1, 2 & 3

28 Gauge - 50 targets
28 ga Shoot off immediately follows

2:45 PM ROTATION - Fields 1, 2 & 3

410 Bore - 50 targets
410 bore Shoot off immediately after
Followed by the HOA Shoot off

<u>DOUBLES - 50 targets</u>
<u>Followed by the Doubles & HAA Shoot offs</u>

This is a 5-gun, 250 targets NSSA registered competition and is limited to 15 shooters in each event. All NSSA rules apply. The all-inclusive entry fee for each gun and doubles is \$25 and includes lunch. Honors only, no purse included.

There is an optional \$5.00 per gun bet as well as a \$5.00 optional HOA & HAA bet.

Depending on how many participants in each, the prize pool will be distributed by the following formula

1-6 shooters 100% to CH 7-12 60/40 split to CH & RU 13 or more split 50/30/20 to CH, RU & 3rd

Please register in advance through https://iskeet.org/isreg/. Four gun shooters and five participant squads will have priority. Shooters wishing to shoot together must register together. Confirmations will be emailed separately to all participants.

Shooters must be current members of the National Skeet Shooting Association (NSSA) and if a Florida resident, the Florida Skeet Association (FSA). If not already a member, you can join the FSA for \$10 during registration for this event.

If you have not been a member of the NSSA in the last three years, you will be provided a free, one year limited membership which has a value of \$50.00

CONCURRENTS:

The following NSSA Concurrents apply: Sub-Junior, Junior, Collegiate, Triple-Sub, Sub-Sub Senior, Sub Senior, Senior, Veteran, Senior Veterans, Super Veterans, Ladies, Active Duty Military, Retired Military and Military Veteran.

SHOOT OFFS to include: All Gun Champions, RU & 3rd; All Ladies Gun Champions, RU & 3rd; Class 1st, 2nd & 3rd; Concurrents 1st, 2nd & 3rd; HOA Champion, RU & 3rd; Ladies HOA Champion, RU & 3rd and HAA Champion, RU & 3rd

The Shoot Off format will be doubles from stations 3, 4 & 5, miss and out by station and the HOA shoot off will be shot with 410 bore.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

All squads are required to complete 50 targets in 40 minutes. Please be prepared to shoot and on time (early preferred) and considerate of the following squad.

Eye and hearing protection are required for all competitors and skeet personnel.

DISCLAIMERS:

Management reserves the right to change the shoot program as conditions warrant, and to refund, reject, or disqualify any contestant who, in management's judgment, interferes with the administration, harmony, or sportsmanship of the shoot.

It is the sole responsibility of the shooter to verify all entry information before leaving the registration area.

Any squad or shooter not ready when called will be placed on a space available basis. If none available, the squad or shooter will not be able to shoot that event and no refunds will be issued in this case.

Shooters will provide their own proof shells.

Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accident or loss of property occurring on HCTSC property.

Cancellation refunds will be handled on a case by case basis.

From I-10

- 1. Take exit #56/CRESTVIEW/NICEVILLE onto SR-85 S 11.8 mi
 - 2. Bear Right on SR-123 5.0 mi
 - 3. Bear Right on SR-85 S 0.8 mi
 - 4. Bear Right on GEN. ROBERT M BOND BLVD 1.2 mi
- 5. Bear right onto LEWIS TURNER BLVD (SR-189 S) approx 1/2 mi
 - 6. Turn Right (North) on Ranger Road approx 0.25 mi
 - 7. Turn Right into the gate at the Hurlburt Skeet Range

From Hwy 98 East (from Pensacola)

- 1. Proceed on US-98 E, turn Left on MARY ESTHER BLVD (SR-393 N) 1.8 mi
 - 2. Bear Left on LEWIS TURNER BLVD (SR-189 N) approx 5 mi
 - 3. Turn Left (North) on Ranger Road 0.5 mi
 - 4. Turn Right into the entrance at the Hurlburt Skeet Range

From Hwy 98 West (from Panama City)

- 1. Proceed on US-98 W after crossing Brooks Bridge into Fort Walton Beach
 - 2. Turn Right on FLORIDA PL SE (SR-85) 0.1 mi
 - 3. Turn Right to SR-85 6.3 mi
 - 4. Turn Left on LEWIS TURNER BLVD (SR-189 S) 2.5 mi
 - 5. Turn Left on Ranger Road approx. 0.5 mi
 - 6. Turn Right into the entrance at the Hurlburt Skeet Range
