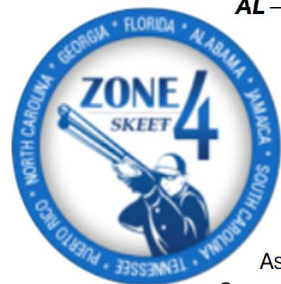

GENERAL INFORMATION

The NSSA has contributed a \$1000.00 grant to our Zone Shoot. The money is to be awarded to HOA Class 1ST, 2ND, and 3RD place winners and will be prorated based upon the number of 4-gun entries in each class. There is no entry fee for this event.

ANY SHOOTER WHO IS MISCLASSIFIED OR INCORRECTLY ENTERED/NOT ENTERED IN AN EVENT AND NOT CORRECTED PRIOR TO SHOOTING WILL FORFEIT ALL MEDALS AND OPTION MONIES FOR THAT EVENT. THE CLASS WILL BE CORRECTED, BUT NO FURTHER ACTION WILL BE TAKEN.

Eligibility and Classification

1. This is a closed event. All participants must be current members of the NSSA and be a resident of Zone 4, verified from the members NSSA record and in accordance with Rule II-C-3.
2. Shooters must present their classification/shoot record card with all scores shot prior to current date properly and legibly recorded.
3. Eligibility for AAA class will be determined based on average at the last classification or reclassification of the appropriate gauge.
4. Teams are not required to shoot shoulder-to-shoulder but must shoot at the same host site.
5. A participant's HOA class will not be lower than his or her lowest gun class.

Registration

1. Participants are highly encouraged to pre-register online at <https://iskeet.org/isreg>
2. On-site registration hours are as follows: Friday, August 8th, 11 AM—6 PM. All other days, 8 AM.
3. Shooters participating in fewer than the entire 4-gun program will be scheduled as near to their requested times as possible but must allow for scheduling needs of shoot management.
4. To participate in any HOA event, shooters must register and pay entry fees for all associated events before beginning the first gauge of their chosen event.
5. There will be no refunds for withdrawals, except in the case of extreme emergencies. There will be no refunds for withdrawal or cancellation due to adverse weather conditions.
6. Anyone entering an event for which they are not eligible will not be given a refund if the error is not discovered until after they have shot the event.

Shooting Procedures

1. Unless otherwise stated in the program or posted in the registration area, current NSSA rules will be used throughout the tournament.
2. All events will be 100 targets on a field using the flight system. Each flight will have one and a half hours to shoot 100 targets. Each flight will start on time, and in the case of breakdown, slow squad, etc., shoot management reserves the right to move the squad to a practice field.
3. Any squad or shooter not ready when called will be placed on a space available basis. If space is not available, the squad or shooters will not be able to shoot the event. No refunds will be issued in these cases.
4. All changes to a squad line up must be made at registration prior to shooting the event. Any changes made on the field without the permission of shoot management will result in the disqualification of those participants for that event.
5. Shooters will provide their own proof shells.

Shoot-offs and Ties

Shoot-offs will occur promptly after the day's final event. Shooters are responsible for knowing which shoot-offs they are participating in each day. If a shooter is absent when the shoot-off is called, they forfeit all rights to participate. Management may adjust procedures due to darkness, weather, or other issues, with changes announced promptly.

TO MINIMIZE DELAYS, PLEASE BRING TWO (2) BOXES OF AMMUNITION TO ALL SHOOT-OFFS.

Shoot-off Procedures

1. Shoot-offs will be determined across all locations using the iSkeet software.
2. All events - Doubles Station 3, 4, and 5 - miss and out by station using NSSA rules for procedures for shoot-offs.
3. Shooters will shoot until two misses, or two boxes are completed.

Shoot-off Order (Barring Weather Delays)

Friday Night: Doubles
Saturday Night: 12 And 20-Gauge
Sunday Night: 28-Gauge, .410-bore, And HOA

1. Ties for Gun CH, RU, 3RD, and Class 1, 2, 3 in all Guns, Dbls, and HOA will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by long run.
2. Concurrent ties for CH, RU, 3RD and Class 1 CH will be shot off. All other ties will be decided by long run.
3. Long runs in all guns and Dbls. will be decided from the front or back scoring of that gun. Long runs for HOA will be decided by using the scoring from the front of the 12 gauge and the back of the 410-bore.

Other Information:

1. All payouts will be mailed.
2. Shoot management reserves the right to change, cancel, or postpone any part of the program.
3. Shoot management reserves the right to refuse any entry or cause the withdrawal of any participant who annoys, endangers, or interferes with the harmony of the shoot.
4. Spectators and contestants assume all risks resulting from accidents or loss of property occurring on host gun club properties.

MEDALLIONS will be awarded to Gun CH, RU, and 3RD in: DBLS, 12, 20, 28, AND 410

BELT BUCKLES will be awarded to: HOA, CH, RU, 3RD, and CLASS 1ST (AAA-D)

Offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA

(by Class – ties divide)

HANDICAP OPTION: Entry Fee \$10.00 per event

Offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA

Maximum Score – ties divide

12 GA BCDE OPTIONS: Entry fee \$10.00 per event.

Offered in 12-gauge event only for shooters in B, C, D, or E Class. All shooters shooting a perfect round of 25 in any round of 12 GA will be eligible to split the pot.

LEWIS CLASS OPTION: Entry Fee \$10.00 per event

Offered in Dbls, 12, 20, 28, .410, and HOA
