Fong is a Singapore-born American studio potter and teacher, who creates diminutive, sculptural porcelain teapots, using a combination of hand building and wheel throwing.

He is best known for his use of low-fire commercial glazes, firing them to cone 6 to achieve luscious, jewel tone effects.

Fong completed his Masters of Art in Ceramics at the University of Louisville Kentucky in 1994. He has been an adjunct professor and artist-in-residence at Bellarmine University in Louisville, KY since 1990.

Fong makes tiny teapots but, visually, they are anything but small. Fong successfully integrates the form with the surface to make exquisite little works of art. ~ Ceramic Arts Network
