

**Coaches Meeting**  
**WSBPA High School Varsity Championship 2023**  
**March 18-19, 2023 / Lilac Lanes – Spokane, WA**

1. Singles and Doubles event for **ALL** bowlers on Saturday, March 18, 2023. 100% handicap.
2. **Singles Championship:**
3. All bowlers will roll three games on the same assigned pair of lanes. 100% handicap against 220.
4. Following the three game of qualifications, the top 3 bowlers will compete in a stepladder, single game elimination. 3<sup>rd</sup> versus 2<sup>nd</sup>, winner versus top seed to determine the State Singles Champion.
  
5. **Doubles Championship**
6. All doubles teams will roll three games. 100% handicap against 440. Two divisions based on entering averages.
7. Top 3 teams in each division will compete in a stepladder, single game elimination. 3<sup>rd</sup> versus 2<sup>nd</sup>, winner versus top seed to determine the State Doubles Champion.
  
8. **Team Championship:**
9. 4 person teams will roll 5, one game matches against teams in their same division.
10. One point will be awarded for each game won head-to-head and two points for each game won by total pins. Total 6 points possible per match. Total points and total pins will determine winners.  
Teams bowling against the blind score: Individuals must bowl within 10 pins of your entering average to win one point. Teams must bowl within 40 pins of the team entering average to win the 2 total pins points.
11. Competition will be 100% handicap against 880. Two divisions based on entering averages.

**General Procedures**

1. Coach or team captain must sign bottom of the recap sheets, immediately after each matches before scores are officially recorded.
2. Only one bowling ball on the ball return rack for each bowler.
3. Please be respectful of others equipment by making sure you do not accidentally pick up the wrong ball when moving to the next game.
4. **One coach only** in bowlers' area. Additional coaches and parents please remain on the concourse level. Only the 4 students bowling each game in the bowling area.
5. If a bowler does not show or becomes injured, their average minus 10 pins will bused for the remainder of the event.
6. Scoring corrections can be made directly by the mutual agreement of the coaches.
7. Pinsetter or foul line malfunctions may also be resolved by the mutual agreement of the two coaches. For any disputes, see one of the tournament officials
