## Dr. Mark Pearce



Mark Pearce began his musical career while still in high school, his singing voice and piano skills being in high demand in the community. During his undergraduate and early graduate years at the University of Utah he was a fixture in various vocal studios as a highly respected studio and recital accompanist. Not satisfied with being known just as a singer and piano player, he returned to the “U” for a master’s degree in choral conducting where he worked with Ed Thompson and Bernell Hales as a teaching assistant.

As a tenor he has had many professional solo opportunities with organizations including the Utah Symphony Orchestra, the Robert Shaw Festival Singers and the Mormon Tabernacle Choir (now the “Tabernacle Choir at Temple Square”) of which he was a member for seven years. He retired from the choir to pursue a doctorate in Music Education which he received in 2007.

Outside of his day job as a music educator, Mark has always been involved in conducting music, his first professional position being the music director of the Salt Lake Vocal Ensemble. He was soon tapped by Dr. J. Marlowe Nielson to be the assistant director of Salt Lake Pro Musica. Then in 1985 he was recruited to be the director of the choir of the Cathedral of the Madeleine in Salt Lake City, the only non-Catholic to hold that position. He has also served as music director and conductor for many community musical theater performances.

While still a college undergraduate Mark joined the Oratorio Society of Utah where he soon became hired as the rehearsal accompanist, and later, Assistant Music Director. He became Music Director and Conductor in 2016, succeeding his long-time mentor, Dr. Morris Lee, and has continued the organization's tradition of excellence.

Mark leaves the OSU with mixed feelings. He is excited about serving a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints along with his wife, Robin. But he will miss the wonderful people of the Oratorio Society and the privilege of recreating with them some of the greatest and noblest music ever composed.
